

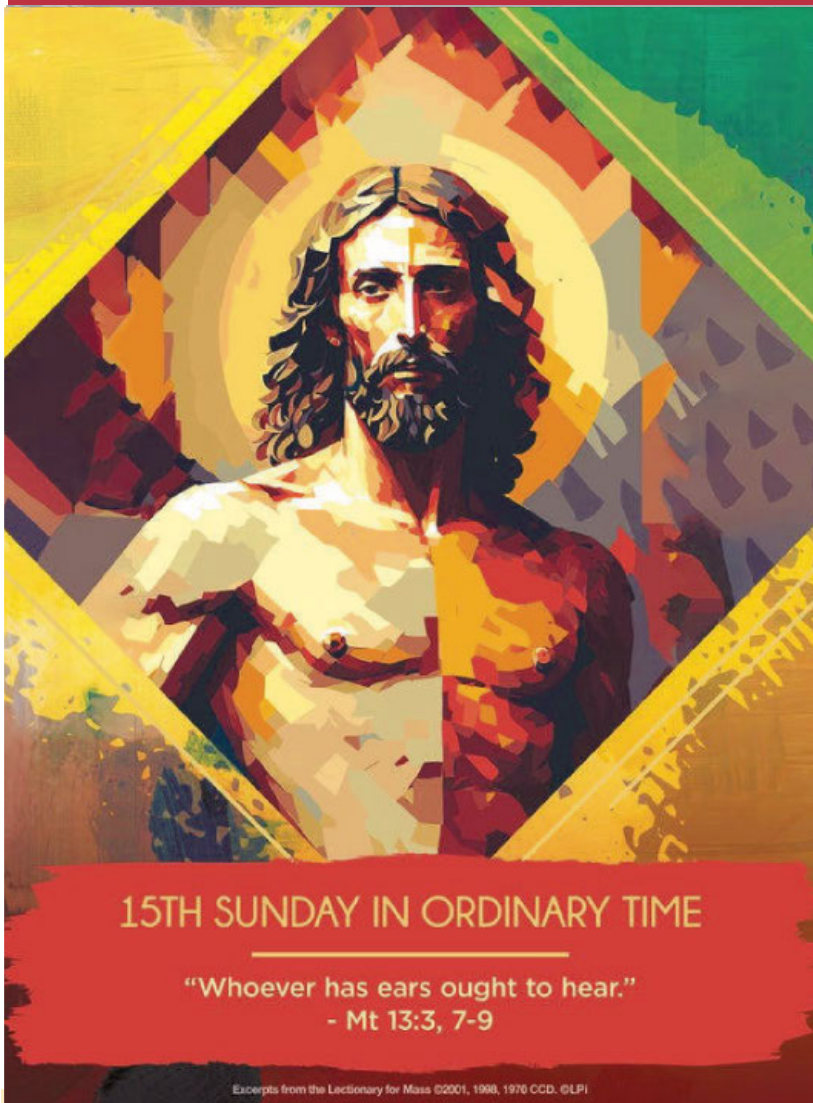

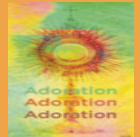
Bible Study (Wednesday Evening)
