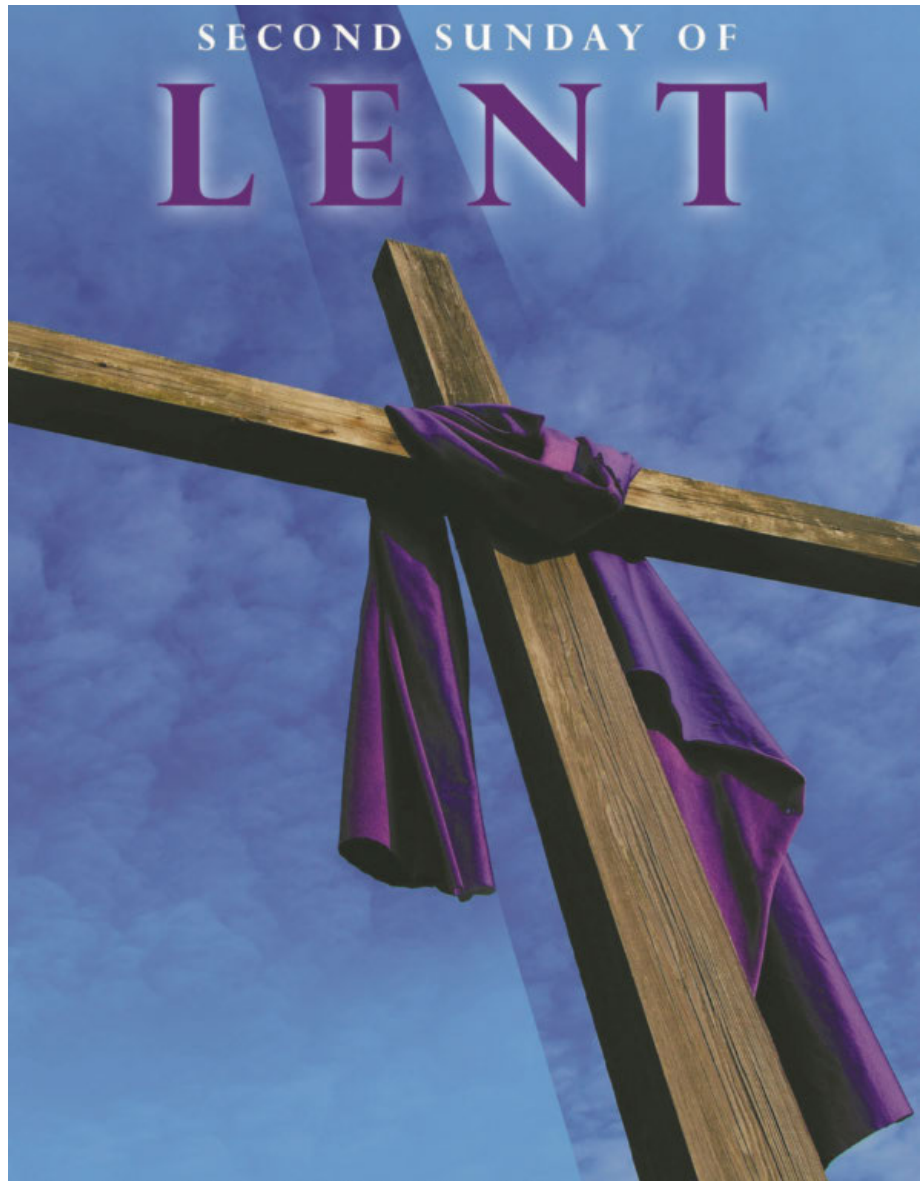

For those who do not want to take the survey online, we have printed surveys at both St. Ann and St. Gertrude parish offices. 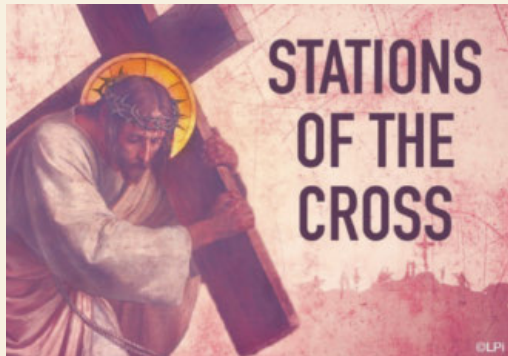
