From the Pastor's Pen

I have 2 updates, the first is about *Fr. Bernie* and the second is about *All Things New* (letter below). As you know, Fr. Bernie has had a bad cough the past few weeks. Due to the cough he hasn't been eating or drinking much. We took him to several doctors who ran every test—EKG, CT Scans, Chest X-rays and a battery of blood tests—but the tests showed nothing. Due to him not eating or drinking he was getting weaker to the point that on Saturday he couldn't even get out his chair to go to the bathroom; we got him

admitted into the hospital by Saturday afternoon.

He responded well to the IV fluids (he was dehydrated) and his electrolytes are now in balance. He was discharged on Monday to a rehab facility: **Ballwin Ridge Nursing Home** (1441 Charic Dr, Wildwood, MO 63021); he is still weak and needs to get his strength back. Certainly our hope is that he will be able to return to us . . . but we must be realistic: his is 87 years old and he will need to be able to rehab to the point that he can climb steps - the bedrooms and showers are on the 2nd floor at both St. Gertrude's and St. Ann's rectory. PLEASE keep Fr. Bernie in your prayers!!!

All Things New Update

Please let me first say thank you for participating in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). We have heard from nearly 70,000 Catholics in the Archdiocese and paper survey copies are still be entered. The DMI results will provide meaningful insight to beliefs, effectiveness and drivers for each parish and the whole of the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Results for each parish and the Archdiocese will be published in June, 2022. Each parish is responsible for publishing its own results while the Archdiocesan results will be available on the *All Things New* website and published in the St. Louis Review. Again, thank you for your participation.

What comes next? In May, Pastors, Key Parish Leaders and Primary Points of Contacts for each parish will attend a webinar hosted by the Catholic Leadership Institute. The webinar will equip the parish leadership team to analyze and publish the parish DMI results. Additionally, each parish team will review and validate the demographic, sacramental, ministerial, and financial data for the parish.

This summer the ATN Parish Leadership team will ask parishioners based on the data what they believe to be the top priorities for evangelization and social outreach in their local area. This feedback will be shared with the ATN office.

During the months of October and November, each parish will host two listening sessions that will included facilitated presentations on parish and school draft models. Parishioners will be invited after the session to provide feedback on the draft models.

Since *All Things New* has begun, parishioners from all over the Archdiocese have shared their insights, creative ideas, and thoughts for revitalizing our parishes and schools. We appreciate hearing from everyone. However, I think it is important to clarify that *All Things New* seeks to reimagine our current models and methods of evangelization; not change the faith. Church teaching is not something that falls under the scope of *All Things New*. We remain steadfast in our faith while moving forward in hope.


