

What is the DMI?


This past Spring, parishioners here at St. Gertrude and across the Archdiocese of St. Louis were invited to share their thoughts, reflect on their spiritual growth as well as provide parish leadership with invaluable insight regarding their parish's strengths and opportunities through a survey, the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The DMI survey is designed to capture information regarding attitudes and beliefs, relationship and satisfaction, participation, and demographics using a quantitative tool that can be used for benchmarking and trending information.

Key Observations:


- ◆73% of our parishioners stated that they are very happy with our Pastor and would recommend him to a friend.
- ♦87% of parishioners agree or strongly agree that we are a very welcoming parish and they would recommend St. Gertrude to others.
- ♦87% of our parishioners feel that they are actively growing in their faith from the preaching that is done at Mass by Fr. Carl and Deacon Charlie. 84% of those same parishioners agree or strongly agree that the experience that they have at Mass each day/weekend helps them grow in their faith.
- ♦89% of parishioners who took the DMI agree or strongly agree that information availability at our parish is headed in the right direction. There are many different avenues that our parish uses to communicate activities while reminding parishioners to stay faithful.
- ♦ What we need most growth in is evangelization. This can happen in many different ways for us. Ways we can better do this is to learn how to share our personal stories of our faith and stories of Jesus with others. Also encourage the discussion of entering the priesthood or other religious orders.






