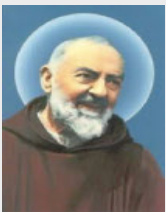

Form your conscience; take a stance for life, marriage and religious liberty.

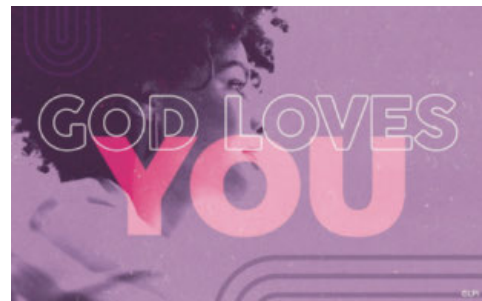
