

From the Pastor's Pen

I want to begin by thanking you for your kindness and concern. Many have asked how I'm "holding up" without Fr. Bernie; all in all, I'm doing well. I miss his friendship and I miss his help at the parish, but now that he's been gone two months, I'm settling into a routine that works for me. Our 2 Deacons have been a wonderful help: they are preaching at Sunday Masses and taking Sunday baptisms—this gives me (and my voice) a break! Even more, it gives YOU another perspective on the Sunday readings. [About my voice: I

have been taking allergy medicine since I was 10 years old. Instead of growing out of my allergies, my allergies have only gotten worse over my 65 years. Every day I take multiple allergy medications and two different nasal sprays—and 3 months ago I finished a five-year allergy-shot regimen. It's my allergies that affect my voice, yet if I had not begun allergy shots in 2017, I would have never survived the Krakow-Clover Bottom pollen when I was assigned here in 2019. In God's Providence, He was preparing me for this wonderful assignment!! I apologize for my raspy voice, but it's a good as I can give. As was mentioned in last week's bulletin and as you read in the St. Louis Review, all priests attended a five hour meeting on Friday, August 19th. At that meeting we were shown the preliminary parish groupings for the entire Archdioceses, which projects reducing the current 187 parishes to 70-90 parishes in 2023. A daunting task is ahead of us, but having seen the plan I can say it is fair and consistent; the same metrics are applied in all rural, urban and suburban areas of the Archdiocese. At this meeting the priests looked at all 15 Planning Areas and gave suggestion for revisions.


Currently, the average parish size in the Archdiocese is 800 families—with *All Things New*, the average parish size will be 1,800 families. Currently 46% of parishes are under 500 families—with *All Things New*, only 11% of parishes will be under 500 families. With *All Things New* 33% of parishes will be 1,800 families; 21% of parishes will be 2,000-3,000 families, and 20% of parishes will be over 3,000 families. (For perspective, currently St. Gertrude is 625 families; St. Ann is 170 families.)

On Wednesday, September 21st, the five parish leaders of every parish in our Planning Area (the Washington Deanery) will meet in St. Louis for a three hour meeting to look at these revised clusters of parishes in the Washington Deanery and give more suggestions and revisions. In Mid-October we will have our individual parish 'town halls' where you will be invited to see the latest revisions to the Washington Deanery parish clusters, and at this meeting you will be able to give your suggestions and revisions.

All of this is to say: things are about to get "real" real quick! Please keep all of this in your prayers and pray to be open to the Spirit; God is calling all of us to something new.






