From the Pastor's Pen

I encourage you to please register to attend one of our two **Parish Listening Sessions**— **BOTH will be exactly the same so only register for one!** I also encourage you to look at our “Parish Workbook” - links for both Registration and the Workbook are on our parish website. If you’re not comfortable with the computer just call the parish office and the secretary will register you and print-out a workbook for you.

Since Fr. Bernie has retired we have reduced daily Masses at our two parishes. With that, there are less “Mass Intentions” available. Please be patient with us (especially our parish secretaries!) as we adjust to the reduction—there are NO Mass Intentions available till after January 1st.

Madison (8th grade) and Luke (6th grade) Diener, parishioners at St. Ann’s and students at St. Gertrude School, each donated \$150 of their Fair sale (they each raised a pig) to the St. Gertrude Tuition Assistance Fund. I am very touched by their sacrifice and sense of “giving back” - thanks goes to them and to their parents (Bryan and Laura Diener) who instilled this important value within them.

Every five years the Archdiocese of St. Louis gathers all the priests for a one-week workshop called “Convocation”. This is the year we meet, so I will be gone October 3rd-7th . . . as will all other Archdiocesan priests. During this time Deacon Charlie and Deacon Dave will have daily Communion Services, and if there are any funerals, either the Deacons can have a funeral & burial service, or we can have the funeral any time after I return. This again is another hint of the changes ahead in *All Things New*.

With *All Things New* and our not knowing what our future parish will look like, I recommend we NOT have Parish Council elections this year. With all the changes coming up, I’d appreciate if the current Councils would remain the same and help with the transition.

Our St. Ann/St. Gertrude Knights of Columbus Council has paid for the repair of St. Gertrude’s BBQ shed walk-in cooler. We thank them for their incredible generosity as we ALL benefit (and enjoy!) the summer Sunday BBQ and the winter Cabin Fever BBQ.

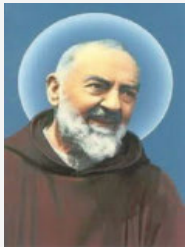

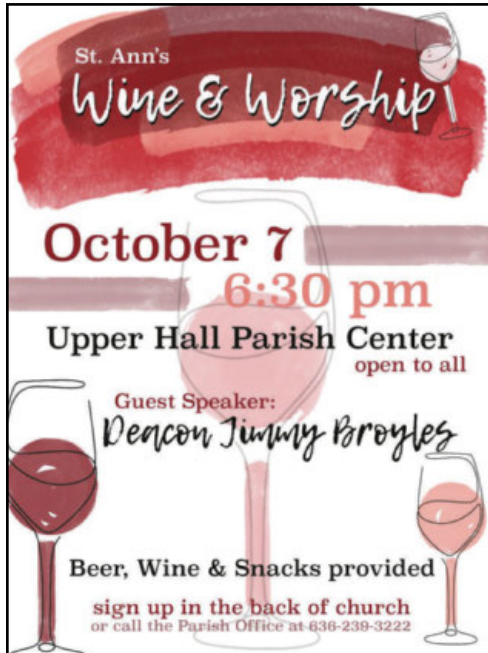
