





OUR CATHOLIC HERITAGE IN ARKANSAS

Pre-Diocesan Era 1541-1843

French in Arkansas (continued from The Baptism of the Lord)

Henri De Tonti:

Henri De Tonti was born in Italy. He was granted permission to form the first European settlement in the lower Mississippi River Valley near the junction of the Arkansas and Mississippi Rivers. Historians have often referred to him as the "Father of Arkansas." While De Tonti had great plans for the settlement called Arkansas Post, there was never much of a settlement in the area. In 1689 De Tonti granted the Jesuits a large parcel of land to establish

a chapel and a mission house asking only that they build two chapels, raise a cross fifteen feet high and say a Mass for De Tonti on his feast day. Because of war with the Indians the plan never materialized. When De Tonti returned after a nine-year absence, he discovered his town abandoned. Henri de Tonti relocate to the Gulf coast and died near what is now Biloxi, Mississippi in 1704.

First Mass in Arkansas

Only an accident brought a priest to the Quapaw Indians of Arkansas in the fall of 1700. A Jesuit, Father Joseph de Limoges, and two companions were traveling down the Mississippi River. Their boat capsized and they were able to cling to a tree and float with the current. After about three hours, they were able to reach shore. The three men were able to build a raft and then continue down the river. Eventually, they reached the friendly Quapaw Indians who helped them find the overturned canoe. They were able to salvage only Father de Limoges' chalice. After resting a few days, they continued their journey downstream. Another Jesuit Father Jacques Gravier, stopped at the Quapaw village on October 31, 1700. He ate with them and after a meal gave them instructions on Christianity. The next morning, November 1, the Feast of All Saints, he said Mass for the Indians. This was the first recorded Catholic Mass within the present boundaries of Arkansas and the Catholic Diocese of Little Rock.

Era pre-diocesana 1541-1843

Francés en Arkansas (continuación de El Bautismo del Señor)

Henri De Tonti:

Henri de Tonti nació en Italia. Se le concedió permiso para formar el primer asentamiento europeo en la parte baja del valle del río Mississippi, cerca de la unión de los ríos Arkansas y Mississippi. Los historiadores a menudo se han referido a él como el "Padre de Arkansas". Si bien De Tonti tenía grandes planes para el asentamiento llamado Arkansas Post, nunca hubo un gran asentamiento en el área. En 1689, De Tonti otorgó a los jesuitas una gran parcela de tierra para establecer una capilla y una casa de misión pidiéndoles solo que construyeran dos capillas, levantarán una cruz de quince pies de altura y ofrecieran una misa por De Tonti en su fiesta. Debido a la guerra con los indios, el plan nunca se materializó. Cuando De Tonti regresó después de una ausencia de nueve años, descubrió que su pueblo estaba abandonado. Henri de Tonti se mudó a la costa del Golfo y murió cerca de lo que ahora es Biloxi, Mississippi en 1704.

Primera Misa en Arkansas

Solo un accidente trajo a un sacerdote a los indios quapaw de Arkansas en el otoño de 1700. Un jesuita, el padre Joseph de Limoges, y dos compañeros viajaban por el río Mississippi. Su bote volcó y pudieron agarrarse a un árbol y flotar con la corriente. Después de unas tres horas, pudieron llegar a la orilla. Los tres hombres pudieron construir una balsa y luego continuar río abajo. Eventualmente, llegaron a los amigables indios quapaw que los ayudaron a encontrar la canoa volcada. Solo pudieron salvar el cáliz del padre de Limoges. Despues de descansar unos días, continuaron su viaje río abajo. Otro padre jesuita, Jacques Gravier, se detuvo en el pueblo de Quapaw el 31 de octubre de 1700. Comió con ellos y después de la comida les dio instrucciones sobre el cristianismo. A la mañana siguiente, 1 de noviembre, fiesta de Todos los Santos, dijo Misa por los indios. Esta fue la primera misa católica registrada dentro de los límites actuales de Arkansas y la Diócesis Católica de Little Rock.





