

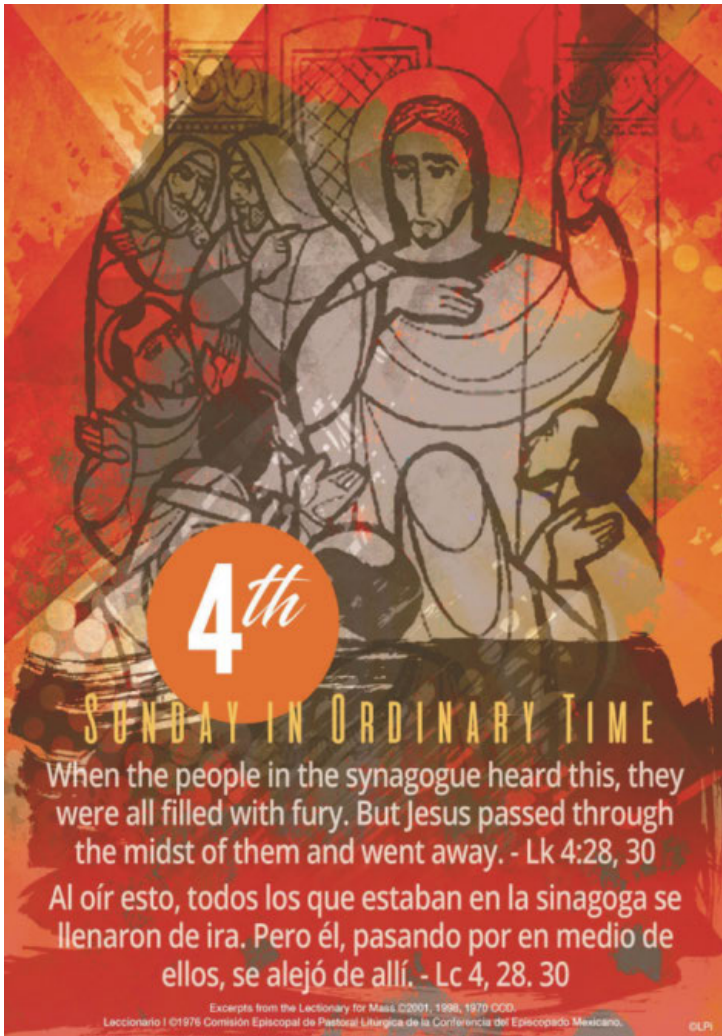

OUR CATHOLIC HERITAGE IN ARKANSAS

Pre-Diocesan Era 1541-1843

French in Arkansas (continued from the Third Week of Ordinary Time)

Father Paul Du Poisson

Father Paul du Poisson arrived on July 7, 1727 and was the first resident priest since Father Foucault's murder. He was described as a good, zealous man with a great deal of common sense. He believed that he was to serve all the people in the Arkansas area, Indians as well as the French who were residing at the Post. When he visited and talked with the Native Americans, he did not try to influence them with gifts and trinkets. He told them of the "Great Spirit." Whom they did not know. He told them that he brought only things that would help them learn more of the "Great Spirit." Father du Poisson was referred to as the "black chief" due to his long, black cassock. When Father arrived in the summer of 1727, he found the settlement in bad condition. He wrote his Superior that:

The time I have had to give to the sick has not prevented me exhorting every Sunday and every feast day, an address during Mass and an address of instruction after Vespers. I have the consolation of seeing that the greater part of them have profited by it and have come to the Sacraments, and that the rest are inclined to do so. It is indeed a reward for the greatest labor if they are followed by the conversion of even one sinner.

Father du Poisson was not only priest to the area; he was also called upon to maintain order and settle disputes among the populace. A Jesuit brother, Philip Crucy, was sent to help Father du Poisson. Crucy came to the Post in late 1727. He died in early November of 1729. Father du Poisson buried his needed assistant and left for New Orleans to confer about Indian migration and other matters. Father stopped in Natchez on November 26, 1729 and said Mass the next day, the first Sunday of Advent. The very next day, Father said Mass and was on his way to take communion to the sick when a large Indian seized the priest, threw him to the ground and cut off his head with a hatchet. Father Paul de Poisson was the first Jesuit to shed his blood for the Gospel in the Mississippi River Valley and the second priest to lose his life after a short stay at the Post.

NUESTRO PATRIMONIO CATÓLICO EN ARKANSAS

Era pre-diocesana 1541-1843 Francés en Arkansas (continuación de la Tercera Semana del Tiempo Ordinario)

Padre Paul Du Poisson El padre Paul du Poisson llegó el 7 de julio de 1727 y fue el primer sacerdote residente desde el asesinato del padre Foucault. Fue descrito como un hombre bueno, celoso y con mucho sentido común. Él creía que iba a servir a todas las personas en el área de Arkansas, tanto a los indios como a los franceses que residían en el Post. Cuando visitó y habló con los nativos americanos, no trató de influir en ellos con regalos y baratijas. Les habló del "Gran Espíritu". a quien no conocían. Les dijo que solo traía cosas que les ayudarían a aprender más del "Gran Espíritu". El padre du Poisson fue referido como el "jefe negro" debido a su sotana larga y negra. Cuando el Padre llegó en el verano de 1727, encontró el asentamiento en malas condiciones. Escribió a su Superior que:

El tiempo que he tenido para dar a los enfermos no me ha impedido exhortar cada domingo y cada fiesta, un discurso durante la Misa y un discurso de instrucción después de Vísperas. Tengo el consuelo de ver que la mayor parte de ellos se han aprovechado y han venido a los Sacramentos, y que los demás se inclinan a hacerlo. De hecho, es una recompensa por el trabajo más grande si van seguidos por la conversión de un solo pecador.

El padre du Poisson no solo era sacerdote de la zona; también fue llamado a mantener el orden y resolver disputas entre la población. Un hermano jesuita, Philip Crucy, fue enviado para ayudar al Padre du Poisson. Crucy llegó al Post a fines de 1727. Murió a principios de noviembre de 1729. El padre du Poisson enterró a su asistente necesario y se fue a Nueva Orleans para consultar sobre la migración india y otros asuntos. El Padre se detuvo en Natchez el 26 de noviembre de 1729 y dijo Misa al día siguiente, el primer domingo de Adviento. Al día siguiente, el padre dijo misa y se dirigía a comulgar a los enfermos cuando un indio corpulento agarró al sacerdote, lo tiró al suelo y le cortó la cabeza con un hacha. El padre Paul de Poisson fue el primer jesuita en derramar su sangre por el Evangelio en el valle del río Mississippi y el segundo sacerdote en perder la vida después de una breve estadía en el Post.
