

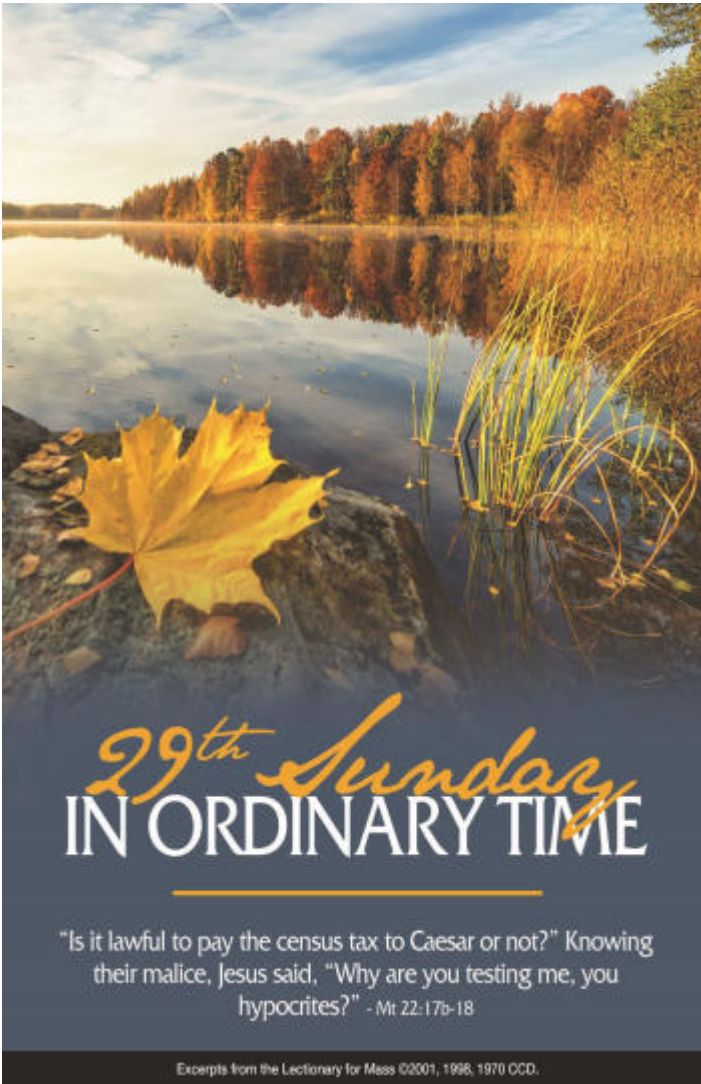

Even with the reinstatement, we will continue to celebrate the Mass publically every weekend for those who are able to attend and willing to strictly follow the proper health protocols. During this time of increased infection, our parish will be even more vigilant in observing the health protocols shared in the diocesan guidelines to prevent the spread of disease and allow as many people as is safe to come to Mass without fear of infection. The wearing of masks is mandatory at Masses celebrated throughout our diocese. Thank you for your support and compliance as we as a community of faith come together to worship in safety.

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Spiritual Sovereignty or Temporal State



Often today's passage is used to reaffirm and to give a biblical foundation, revealed, to the distinction and reciprocal autonomy between the Church and the State. Most likely the answer of Jesus did not have this intention: both for the context of the story, which did not require a pronouncement on this problem; both for the historical context of his times, in which there was still no distinction between political and religious power. But Jesus' answer is equally enlightening because it indicates a direction. The Jews of his time were accustomed to conceiving the kingdom inaugurated by the future Messiah in the form of a theocracy, that is, as a direct dominion of God, through his people, over the whole earth. The word of Jesus reveals the existence of a kingdom of God in history, into which it is possible for everyone, and not just for the Jews, to enter right now, without waiting for the inauguration of a hypothetical political kingdom of God in the entire world. The kingdom of God, in fact, is possible within a pagan kingdom, no less than within the framework of a theocracy, since it is not identified with either one or the other. Thus, two qualitatively different ways of domination and sovereignty of God over the world are revealed: the spiritual sovereignty which constitutes the kingdom of God and which he exercises directly in Christ, and the temporal lordship which he exercises indirectly, through the free play of secondary causes.

The word of Jesus recalls our reflection on one of the most important and crucial problems facing Christians today. Modern man has the profound conviction that he has a historical task to perform on earth, a task that is proportionate to his ever-greater possibilities and that implies real dominion over the universe. The aim is this: the promotion of the human community within an ever more fraternal city. This awareness is sometimes accompanied by a bitter criticism of religion, which is considered to be responsible for the age-old alienation of men. Many take an attitude of disregard towards religion, as if it had no positive contribution to offer. The Christian faith, lived integrally, far from suggesting resignation and evasion towards man's earthly tasks, helps the believer to assume his own responsibilities in achieving the goals that are imposed on modern conscience. The appeals of today's world find an ever-deeper echo in vast strata of the Christian people, and fortunately there are not few consistent Christians who take on the roles of promoting, liberating and building a more just and humane earthly city.

Vatican II has dedicated an important part of its works to the analysis of the concerns of man in the twentieth century, apparently more profane than religious problems, so that the reticence or absences of the Christian of yesterday in relation to his commitment in the world, should be overcome. This construction of earthly city however, a question remains: the construction of the earthly city is an important task, but isn't it lapse? Does building the city of men contribute to building the kingdom of God or not? Aren't they two different realms? Christian hope, of course, is not fully fulfilled except in the future world. However, it shows its effectiveness right now: it is an immense force in the world, it is a ferment that makes it rise, it is a salt that gives meaning and flavor to the human effort of liberation, to the temporal commitment. It is not alienation; it is not an alibi. There are not two hopes: one earthly and the other heavenly, hope is only one: it looks to the future reality, but, through Christian commitment, it is anticipated in earthly reality.
