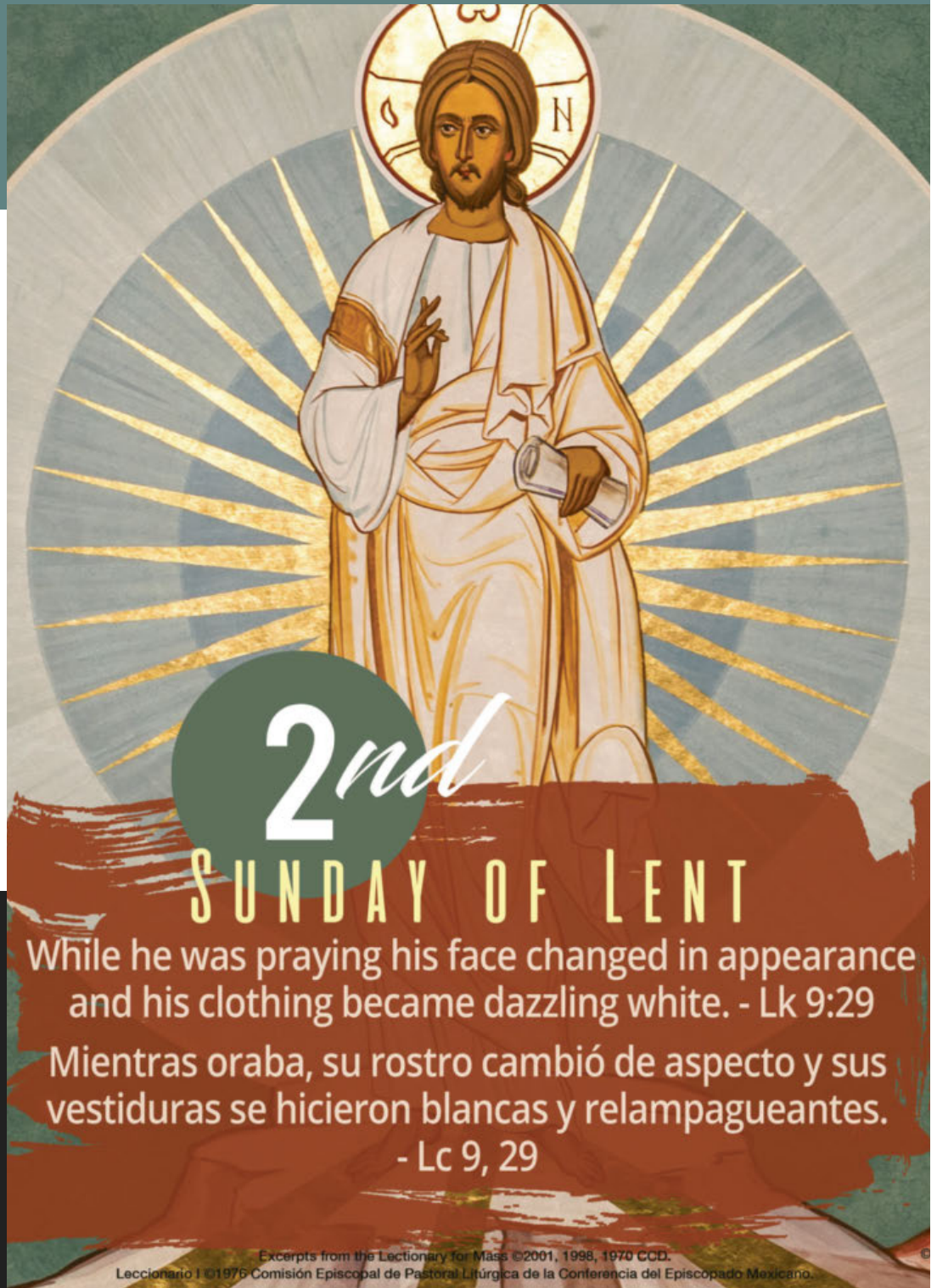

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# PASTOR'S LETTER • CARTA DEL PADRE

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Dear Friends,

I pray your Lenten season is off to a good start. It was great to see the large number of people attending the Ash Wednesday Masses and Ash Service. I think they were the biggest gatherings since before the pandemic! My hope and prayer is that we would have the same crowds of people at EVERY Sunday Mass! Thank you to all the Musicians and Liturgical ministers that made the celebrations beautiful!

During the Lenten season, the Church invites us to spend more time each day in prayer. There are so many needs to pray for in the world, especially now, perhaps a good place to start would be to reflect on the words that we heard on Ash Wednesday, as the ashes were placed on our foreheads: "Remember, you are dust and to dust you shall return." The words used for the imposition of ashes is a reminder to live our earthly life fully aware that through God's grace, an eternal life awaits us.

In an all school mass homily a few months ago, I challenged the students to live by the "Diamond Rule." We are all aware of the "Golden Rule," which says that we should treat others as we want to be treated. The "Diamond Rule" says that we should treat even our enemies as we want to be treated! This is probably the most challenging command the Gospels ask us to live by! In the coming weeks I invite you to pray for Russian President Vladimir Putin, that his eyes are opened to the suffering that the invasion of the Ukraine is inflicting on its people, and is threatening world peace. Please pray that his heart is changed and he stops the war against his neighbor.



I also invite you to join us for a Rosary for the people of Ukraine every day at 3pm. The Rosary will be prayed "virtually" via Zoom. This Lenten season lets us pray for ourselves that our earthly lives are worthy of eternal life, and prayer for the needs of our world. Blessed Virgin Mary, pray for us.

Ruego que su temporada de Cuaresma haya tenido un buen comienzo. Durante el tiempo de Cuaresma, la Iglesia nos invita a pasar cada día más tiempo en oración. Hay tantas necesidades por las que orar en el mundo, especialmente ahora, quizás un buen lugar para comenzar sería reflexionar sobre las palabras que escuchamos el Miércoles de Ceniza, cuando las cenizas fueron colocadas en nuestras frentes: "Recuerda, eres polvo, y en polvo te convertirás." Las palabras utilizadas para la imposición de las cenizas son un recordatorio para vivir nuestra vida terrenal con plena conciencia de que, por la gracia de Dios, nos espera una vida eterna.

En una homilía de toda la escuela en Misa hace unos meses, desafié a los estudiantes a vivir según la "Regla del diamante". Todos estamos conscientes de la "Regla de oro", que dice que debemos tratar a los demás como queremos que nos traten. ¡La "Regla del Diamante" dice que debemos tratar incluso a nuestros enemigos como queremos ser tratados! ¡Este es probablemente el mandamiento más desafiante que los Evangelios nos piden que cumplamos! En las próximas semanas los invito a orar por el presidente ruso Vladimir Putin, para que sus ojos se abran al sufrimiento que la invasión de Ucrania está infligiendo a su pueblo y amenaza la paz mundial. Por favor, oren para que su corazón cambie y detenga la guerra contra su prójimo.

También los invito a unirse a nosotros para rezar el Rosario por el pueblo de Ucrania todos los días a las 3:00 p. m. El Rosario se rezará "virtualmente" a través de Zoom. 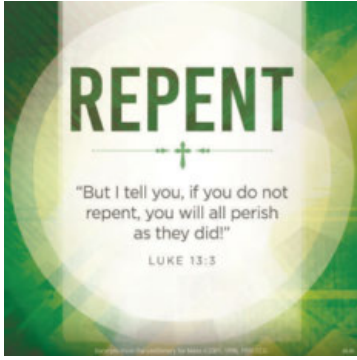

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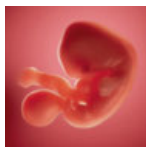

## CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME MINISTRY

A Lenten Study of Pope Francis's encyclical about the environment, Laudato Si' (On Care for our Common Home) has resulted in new ministry here at St. Bartholomew. The new "Care for Our Common Home" Ministry will be part of the Peace and Justice Ministry.

The study took place during Lent of 2021. The group was comprised of nine adult parishioners, which included Frs. Chris and Clem. At completion of the study, the group concluded that some ongoing action should take place. There were two selected:

1. **Contributions to the Weekly Bulletin**, titled "On Care for Our Common Home". The columns are intended to be educational and inspirational. The topics are any of a variety regarding care for the earth, and our stewardship as Christians and earthly citizens. The column was published weekly for several months, and went to monthly recently.
2. **Involvement with the Jr. High level Climate Restoration Team (CRT)** at St. Bartholomew School, to provide them a connection with the parish to help accomplish their goals. The current staff leaders are Cathy Lampton and Quinike "Q" Nusawardhana.

The CRT Students have chosen these projects for 2022:

- **An Earth Day event on April 23.** This includes planting pollinators on Campus, and other possible activities. Students will host the 5:00 Mass that day.
- **An Arbor Day event, weekend of May 14/15.** Hope to include providing tree starts to all parishioners for planting, and approaching City Council about sponsoring a tree planting initiative locally.
- **Establish a Mason Bee Hive** on campus.
- **Implement a Recycling Program** for school and church.

## FRIENDS OF HAITI | AMIGOS DE HAITI

### HAITI LENTEN CARTONS

This week we share what the costs of the Medika Mamba Program are for our collaboration with Hands up for Haiti (HUFH). Karen Schechter, the Executive Director of HUFH shares with us the exact costs of the Medika Mamba Program.

The cost per box of Mamba, which is the general course of treatment if a child graduates timely, is \$69/box. In addition to that cost, HUFH pays the nurses, dispenses essential medications, provides educational materials, professional & community education, and program equipment for a total cost of \$96 per child.

The \$96 cost per child does not include program coordination, administrative and overhead costs in Haiti and the U.S. Other costs that are not included are TSK (community health worker) salaries, shipping equipment and medicines to Haiti, staff education sessions, emergency referrals to hospitals for extremely malnourished children, mobile sante visits to Gede or Limonade and well-baby care. If you look at the photo, it takes roughly \$100 to nourish & heal a child from the first picture to the second. How many children can you save by making sacrifices this Lenten season? Please donate generously to our Haiti Lenten Carton campaign!





### CAJITAS DE CUARESMA PARA HAITÍ

Esta semana compartimos cuáles son los costos del Programa Medika Mamba por nuestra colaboración con Manos para Haití (HUFH). Karen Schechter, el Director Ejecutivo de HUFH comparte con nosotros los costos exactos del Programa de Medika Mamba.


El costo por caja de Mamba, que es el curso general de tratamiento si un niño se gradúa oportunamente, es de \$69/ caja. Además de ese costo, HUFH paga a las enfermeras, ofrece medicamentos esenciales, proporciona materiales educativos, educación profesional y comunitaria, y equipo del programa por un costo total de \$96 por niño.

El costo de \$96 por niño no incluye costos de coordinación de programas, gastos administrativos y gastos generales en Haití y los Estados Unidos. Otros costos que no están incluidos son los salarios de TSK (trabajador de salud comunitario), el envío de equipo y medicamentos a Haití, sesiones de educación del personal, referir a otros hospitales de emergencia a los niños extremadamente desnutridos, Visitas móviles de sante a Gede o Limonade y cuidado de bebés. 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





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
