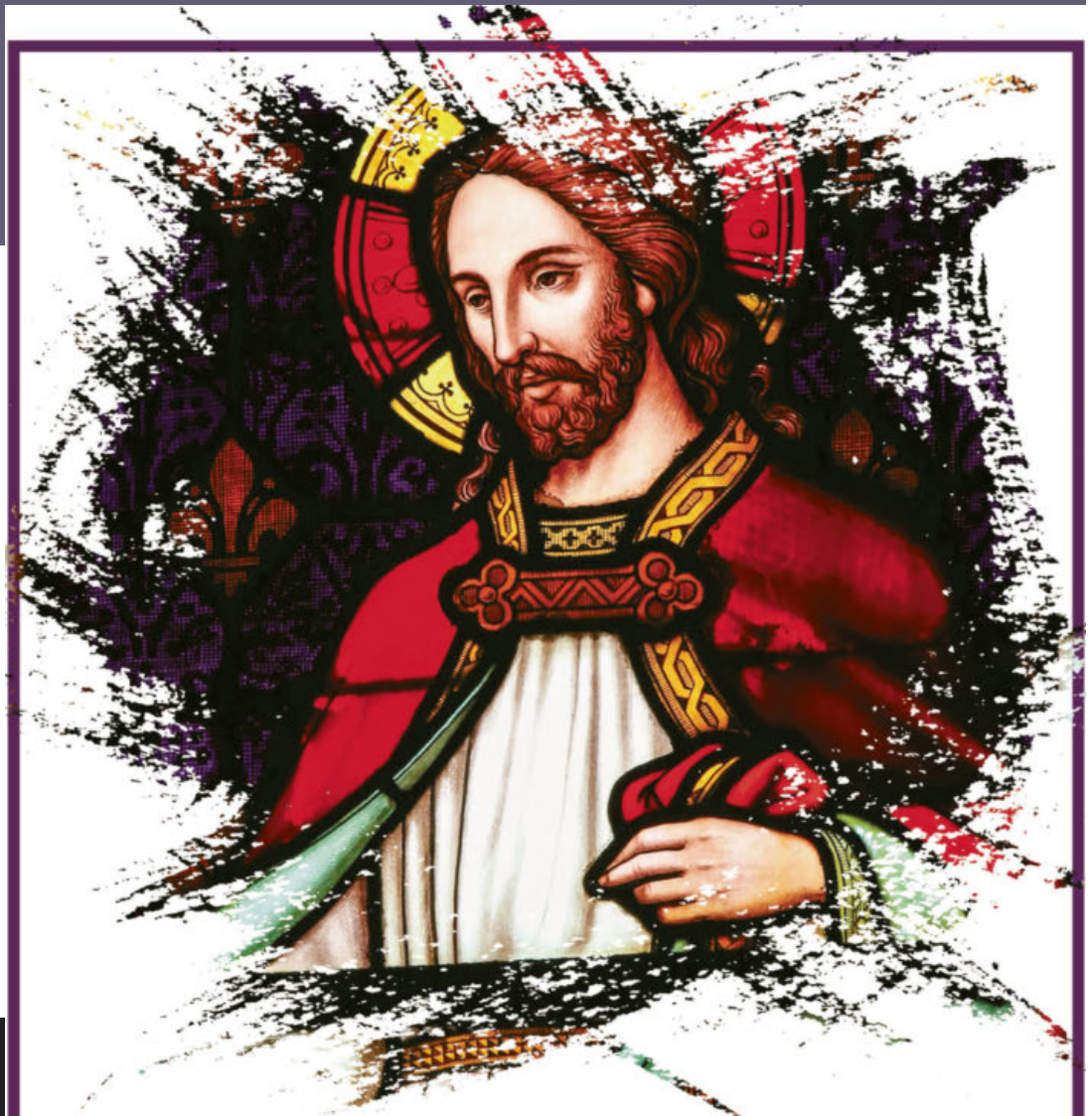

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

March 20, 2022
3rd Sunday of Lent

Deserts can be lonely, isolated, and treacherous places. When a person wanders in a desert, they can easily get disoriented, dehydrated, confused, lost, and vulnerable. Temptation is at its peak, especially when confronted with something that may offer some respite or relief, even a mirage. Deserts can bring us to our weakest moment and tempt our faith. The Christian journey can be described as a desert experience as we vacillate back and forth, falling victim to the mirages of our lives versus the true, life-giving water offered by God. We need a burning bush experience in our lives that convinces us of the power of God and reveals Him as the "I am" of all existence.

Moses was leading his flock across the desert when he found himself at Mount Horeb. Mountains give us a fuller perspective of life, a panoramic view of what would otherwise be hidden from the limitations of our sight. That's when Moses met God. We have to find our way to a mountain experience where our vantage point can take on a wider view of life. Many things can do this for us: the birth of a child, the death of someone we love, the joy that comes from marveling at the beauty of God's work, the pondering of life's mysteries, and the ache of longing found deep within our souls. There are many things in life that can wake us up, give us a clearer, better view of things and become occasions where a bush may burn and God's presence as the eternal uncreated One is revealed.

God is very patient and gives us the time and space we need to figure things out and bear some good fruit. He doesn't rush to cut us down or get frustrated with our barrenness. But we have to remember that the desert journeys of our lives come with some risks. The major risk is that we will mistakenly believe that the mirages are real. Thus, we fall victim to thinking that the respite and refreshment we seek is discovered in a place other than where it actually is. Our faith and the life of the Church are the safeguards we need to keep us properly orientated so that we don't get lost or confused and stay on course.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO – ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA (Gospel Meditations)

20 de marzo de 2022
3er Domingo de la Cuaresma

No se puede echar en saco roto la predicación de Jesús, urge la conversión, el Evangelio evoca diversos motivos para el cambio radical de la persona. La gente le pregunta y él responde con claridad y sencillez. San Gregorio Magno (540-604. Homilía 31, 4), exhorta a las personas con una reflexión profunda sobre la higuera que no da fruto: "Con un grande temor se debe escuchar lo que se dice: Córdala. ¿Para qué ocupa la tierra inútilmente? Cada uno a su manera, si no hace buenas obras. Pero desde el momento que ocupa un espacio en la vida presente, es un árbol que ocupa inútilmente el terreno, porque en ese lugar en donde está, impide que ahí se ponga otro a trabajar".

Continua su homilía. "Pero hay algo más grave, y es que los poderosos de este mundo, si no realizan ningún bien, no lo hacen producir ni siquiera en aquellos que dependen de ellos, porque su ejemplo actúa sobre sus subalternos como una sombra estimulante de perversidad... Sofocados por la sombra no reciben el calor del sol y permanecen fríos, sin el calor de Dios. Pero el pensamiento de este poderoso, cualquiera que sea su nombre, no es más objeto directo de los cuidados de Dios. Dejarnos cuidar por Dios es el mensaje de Cristo. La Iglesia administra cuidadosamente los sacramentos para que sus fieles acudan a recibir el abono por medio de ellos. Los sacramentos de iniciación cristiana son la base. Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía. ¿Los frecuentes? ¿Cómo te ayudan a crecer y dar fruto en tu vida?"

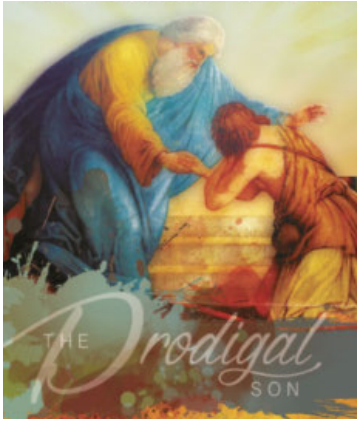

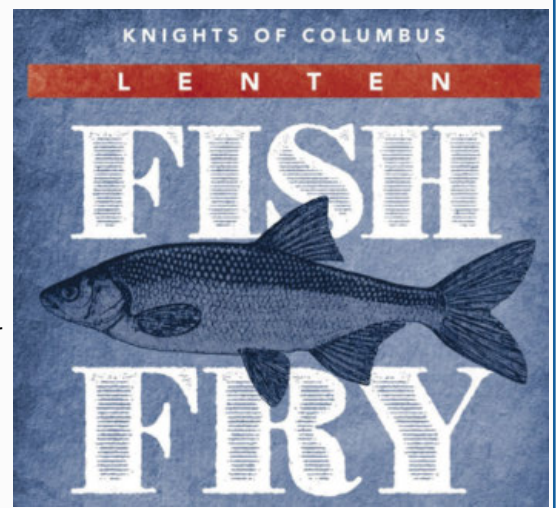

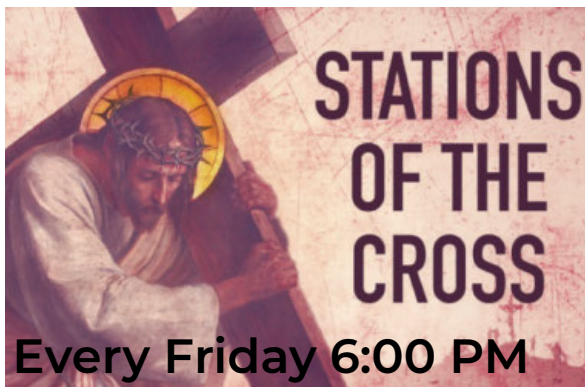

HAITI LENTEN CARTONS

This week we highlight the Prenatal and Newborn Care portion of our collaboration with Hands Up for Haiti (HUFH). Prevention of malnutrition in babies begins in pregnancy! Our community outreach efforts focus on prenatal clinics in Limonade, Gede, Bois-de-Lance, Robillard and Madeleine in Cap Haitien, all of which are run by nurses and community health workers. These medical providers see women monthly in their local communities, where they screen them for diabetes and hypertension, provide treatment as needed, and ensure they have a safe birth plan.



HUFH trains matrones (traditional birth attendants) in newborn resuscitation skills that could be used during the "Golden Minute" immediately after a baby is born to give an increased chance at life to babies who struggle to breathe at birth.

HUFH teaches health care providers essential practices to keep all babies healthy in the first 48 hours after birth, when most infant deaths occur. Through hands-on learning and practice, the course focuses on how to recognize danger signs in newborns, including hypothermia and sepsis, and on improving success in practices such as breastfeeding, cord care, and eye care, all directly connected to health in newborns

We enroll our babies in our follow-up program to connect them with a clinic location to receive necessary immunizations. We see all newborn babies and mothers in our clinics for a postnatal visit within a week to ensure that the babies are gaining weight, breastfeeding well, and to assess for any problems such as jaundice or infection.

As you can see, our collaboration with Hands Up for Haiti provides comprehensive care to both Mother and Baby to ensure them both the best chance at life! Please be generous with your Lenten donation!

CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME MINISTRY

A Lenten Study of Pope Francis's encyclical about the environment, Laudato Si' (On Care for our Common Home) has resulted in new ministry here at St. Bartholomew. The new "Care for Our Common Home" Ministry will be part of the Peace and Justice Ministry.

The study took place during Lent of 2021. The group was comprised of nine adult parishioners, which included Frs. Chris and Clem. At completion of the study, the group concluded that some ongoing action should take place. There were two selected:

1. **Contributions to the Weekly Bulletin**, titled "On Care for Our Common Home". The columns are intended to be educational and inspirational. The topics are any of a variety regarding care for the earth, and our stewardship as Christians and earthly citizens. The column was published weekly for several months, and went to monthly recently.
2. **Involvement with the Jr. High level Climate Restoration Team (CRT)** at St. Bartholomew School, to provide them a connection with the parish to help accomplish their goals. The current staff leaders are Cathy Lampton and Quinike "Q" Nusawardhana.

The CRT Students have chosen these projects for 2022:

- **An Earth Day event on April 23.** This includes planting pollinators on Campus, and other possible activities. Students will host the 5:00 Mass that day.
- **An Arbor Day event, weekend of May 14/15.** Hope to include providing tree starts to all parishioners for planting, and approaching City Council about sponsoring a tree planting initiative locally.
- **Establish a Mason Bee Hive** on campus.
- **Implement a Recycling Program** for school and church.

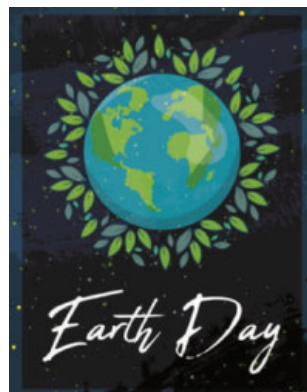
SAVE THE DATE! CELEBRATE EARTH DAY 2022


