Dear Friends,

Just when you thought life could not get any busier... welcome to Mary's month of May!

May has traditionally been a month dedicated to Our Blessed Lady. The Church encourages special devotions to Our Lady during this month as a means of praying for her intercession to instill peace to areas that are in conflict, to give hope in times of distress, and to pray in Thanksgiving for prayers answered. Communities and individual families are encouraged to devote time during May to praying to Mary.

During the month of May various ministry groups in our parish will be leading the Rosary before each weekend Mass. Pro-Life ministry has traditionally lead the Rosary. This year it was decided to expand the leaders to include people from other groups within the Parish as well. Thank you to Pro-Life for coordinating the schedule and encouraging the praying of the Rosary during May.

May is a busy month, and beautiful in so many ways! Last week the School students continued the tradition of crowning Mary in the May Crowning celebration. In this year's beautiful celebration, students reflected on the 12 Stars of Mary's Crown as examples to follow.

We have celebrated the First Communion Masses for our CFF and School students, with the last group celebrating this weekend. Nearly 90 students will receive their First Communion this Spring. I always find it heartwarming to see the excitement of the children as they receive the Eucharist for the first time. I pray it is the start of a full life of remaining close to Christ in the Eucharist.

Next weekend is Confirmation and we are excited to celebrate 41 confirmands making this very important sacrament of initiation.

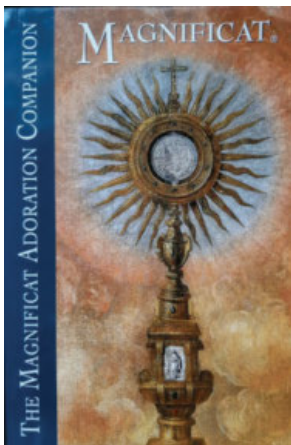


