PASTOR'S LETTER • CARTA DEL PADRE

Dear Friends,

If you are ever searching for a convincing argument for the existence of God, diversity would be a good place to start. The first principle of Physics says that an object will remain at rest or come to rest unless it is acted upon by an external force. We know this is true because we can see that a bouncing ball will stop bouncing, a rolling wave will settle down and a spinning top will eventually stop spinning. Everything in nature moves from a higher to a lower state of energy. The diversity of Creation seems to go against this first principle. If there is not a God, how do we explain that there are 4,000 varieties of Potatoes, 20,000 species of Bees, and over 900,000 types of insects? How do we explain that every single person on the face of the earth, all 7.9 billion people, have individual markers, fingerprints and retinas, that make them unique? Diversity is a sign of God's presence in the world. God is the external force acting upon the world, creating magnificent diversity and abundance, raising humanity from the lowly state of animals, elevating them to rational, thinking, praying creatures capable of co-creating with God. St. Bartholomew, and Columbus, have been richly blessed with a great diversity of cultures from every part of the globe.

On June 4th at the 5:00pm Mass - the Feast of Pentecost - we are going to have a multicultural parish celebration and food festival. People are invited to attend the 5:00pm Mass wearing traditional clothing from their home countries (the brighter the better!), carry Religious images that represent your culture, and proudly display flags from your country of origin for the grand entrance procession. Dr. Minut has put together a wonderful repertoire of music in many different languages, and from various cultures. The readings will be proclaimed in various languages, and we may even hear Fr. Clem utter a few phrases in German. We are still trying to convince Fr. Clem to wear Lederhosen!

It is said that the way to a person's heart is through their stomach. At the conclusion of the Mass, we will be led in procession from the Church to the melodious sounds of a Bagpipe, to a food festival on the side patio (weather permitting). Many dishes from around the world will be available for people to try.

Si alguna vez has buscado un argumento convincente para la existencia de Dios, la diversidad sería un buen lugar para comenzar. El primer principio de la física dice que un objeto permanecerá en reposo o se detendrá a menos que una fuerza externa actúe sobre él. Sabemos que esto es cierto porque podemos ver que una pelota que rebota dejará de rebotar, una ola rodante se calmará y un trompo finalmente dejará de girar. Todo en la naturaleza se mueve de un estado de energía más alto a uno más bajo. La diversidad de la creación parece ir en contra de este primer principio. Si no hay Dios, ¿cómo explicamos que haya 4000 variedades de papas, 20,000 especies de abejas y más de 900,000 tipos de insectos? ¿Cómo explicamos que cada persona sobre la faz de la tierra, los 7.9 billones de personas, tengan marcadores individuales, huellas dactilares y retinas que las hacen únicas? La diversidad es un signo de la presencia de Dios en el mundo. 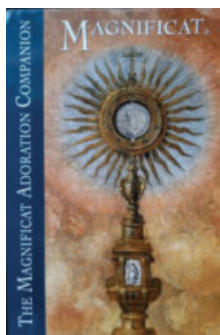


