FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph (JMJ) are the Holy Family. They are the image of the Trinitarian family of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. God created the family to incarnate (make flesh) His love in the world. On Christmas Day, we celebrated the incarnation of love Himself, Jesus Christ. The Second Person of the Trinity took upon Himself our flesh in the Virgin Mary and became man. He became a man in a human family - the family we call Holy.

The Holy Family may seem beyond our imagining when we compare our family to theirs. However, the Holy Family experienced struggles with the world around them, trials that all humans face in a broken world, and suffering that every family faces. They were poor and on the run from an egomaniac, Herod, who wanted to kill God's Son. Joseph and Mary faced the trial of fleeing to Egypt with a newborn. They had to set up a house in a foreign land without family or friends. Joseph had to find a way to provide for and protect his family. Then, at God's prompting, move to Nazareth and start again.

Before Jesus began His public ministry, He and Mary suffered the death of Joseph. Mary watched her son be rejected by those he came to save. She watched him die a gruesome death on the Cross for the ungrateful. Jesus had to suffer this death. But he also had to suffer seeing his mother suffer his death (maybe more painful). None of us will avoid trials, suffering, or death in a world gone wrong because of sin. In other words, holiness does not mean easy.

We must learn the Holy Family's virtues so we can be faithful to the end. Loving obedience to the Word of God. Humility in all circumstances. Trust in the providential care of God. Obedience, humility, and trust in God are the Holy Family's virtues; we should imitate them as we continue our pilgrimage to Heaven. They are a sure path to our happiness.

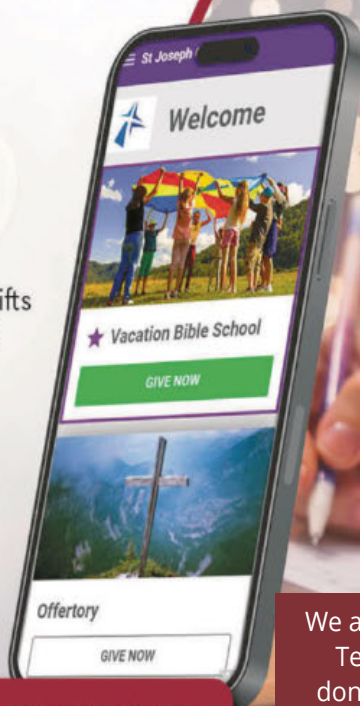

ST. PETER ST. VINCENT DEPAUL ANNUAL REPORT

Through the generosity of our parish, our Knights of Columbus, individual parishioner and community donors, Friends of the Poor Walk donors, and collections at monthly conference meetings from our 19 active members, our St. Peter Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) Society, was able to financially assist 96 Geneva neighbors through 33 home and in-person visits from October 1, 2023- September 30, 2024.

General Contributions.....\$48,647.00

Friends of the Poor Fundraising:.....\$3,121.00

Vehicle Donation.....\$2,738.00

Financial Assistance helped our neighbors in need with these expenses:

Food.....\$1,700.00

Utilities.....\$6,156.00

Medical/Dental.....\$450.00

Household Items.....\$3,406.00

Car-related expenses.....\$5,235.00

Gasoline.....\$1,600.00

Legal/court/tax fees.....\$1,000.00

Educational fees.....\$819.00

Rent payments.....\$16,923.00

Mortgage payments.....\$780.00

Neighbors in need also received free clothing and furniture and other items through the St. Vincent de Paul De Ja Vu Shop in Geneva and the Warehouse in Aurora.

Operating Expenses for dues, insurance, computer, and supplies totaled \$1,138.00. Conservatively, our SVDP members contributed 859 hours of service and covered 808 miles. The heartfelt gratitude of the neighbors in need that we served, our very dedicated members and officers goes out to each of you who offered prayers and resources to this vibrant ministry. We thank Father Browning and the Knights of Columbus for their support and prayers as we reach Geneva neighbors in need. Women in the Old Testament - Thursday mornings - 9am-11am

In Scripture we encounter God and come to know God's people. Women in the Old Testament takes you on a journey through Israel's beginnings, Israel's captivity and freedom, and Israel's tribal period from the perspective of the earliest women of salvation history. While we may know the Bible stories of Israel's military leaders, kings, and prophets, we are often less familiar with the stories of the women who helped to establish a monarchy, defend Israel's interests, and reflect God's image in unique ways.
