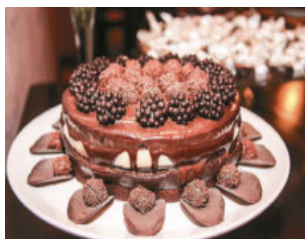


ST. GABRIEL QUILT RAFFLE

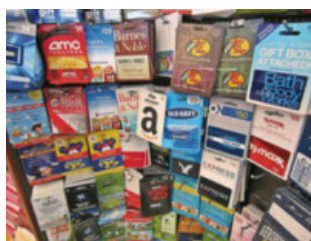

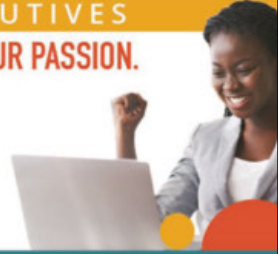

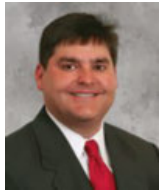
