"EVOLVING" NATIVITY SCENE

St. Gabriel's Nativity Scene will evolve over the course of Advent, the Christmas Octave and Epiphany.

Second Sunday of Advent, December 22 – Mary & Joseph

"At that time a proclamation was made by Caesar Augustus that all the inhabited world should be registered. This was the first census while Quirinius was governor of Syria; and everybody went to the town of his birth to be registered. Joseph went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to David's town, Bethlehem, in Judea, because he was a direct descendant of David, to be registered with his wife, Mary, now in the later stages of her pregnancy" (Luke 2:1-5). Ponder: When life becomes difficult, how strong is my faith? Do I continue to trust God as Joseph and Mary did?



Christmas Eve, December 24 – Baby Jesus



"While they were there, the time came for her to have her child, and she gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." (Luke 2:6-7)

Ponder: God became one of us! God freely chose to become like one of his creations, a human! What crazy amount of love God has for us! How amazingly wonderful!

Visit <http://www.stgabriel.net/background> to submit your name for a background check. The event is also required for any parish employees. No registration is necessary. Sign-in sheets will be available at the workshops. The next available workshop is at 6:30 PM on **January 7** at Flaget Center, 1935 Lewiston Dr., in the Gym. Background checks and Honor Thy Children training must be renewed **every five years**.

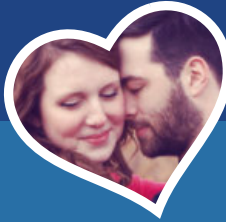
