### Saint of the Week

*Examples of our faith*

St. Thomas Aquinas | January 28

One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, “*The Summa Theologiae*.” Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, encompasses his writings. The *Summa Theologiae*, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology.

The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today.

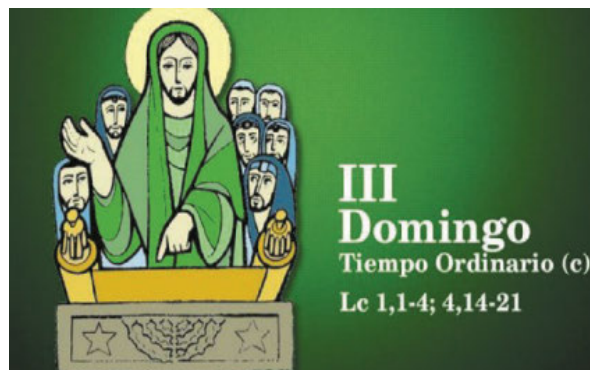

## Tercer Domingo de el Tiempo Ordinario

*Nehemías 8, 2-4a. 5-6. 8-10; Salmo 18, 8. 9. 10. 15; 1ra Corintios 12, 12-30; Lucas 1, 1-4; 4, 14-21*

Queridos Hermanos en la liturgia de hoy, Nehemías, el salmista y Lucas insisten en la lectura y la meditación de la Escritura. El pueblo restaurado tras el exilio inicia su nuevo caminar con la lectura del libro de la ley. Tanto Nehemías como Jesús insisten en el “hoy” como día consagrado a Dios, como tiempo de salvación, como ocasión para la alegría y la celebración. Formando un solo cuerpo con Cristo, así que el texto de el evangelio de hoy nos presenta a Jesús en la Sinagoga proclamando la palabra divina. **“Todos en la sinagoga tenían los ojos fijos en Él”.** Esta actitud de los presentes ilumina de manera elocuente cuál ha de ser también nuestra actitud. Puesto que Cristo “está presente en su palabra” y “cuando se lee en la Iglesia la Sagrada Escritura es Él mismo quien habla” (Sacrosanctum Concilium 7), no tiene sentido una postura impersonal. Sólo cabe estar a la escucha de Cristo mismo, con toda la atención de la mente y del corazón, pendientes de cada una de sus palabras, **“con los ojos fijos en él”.**
