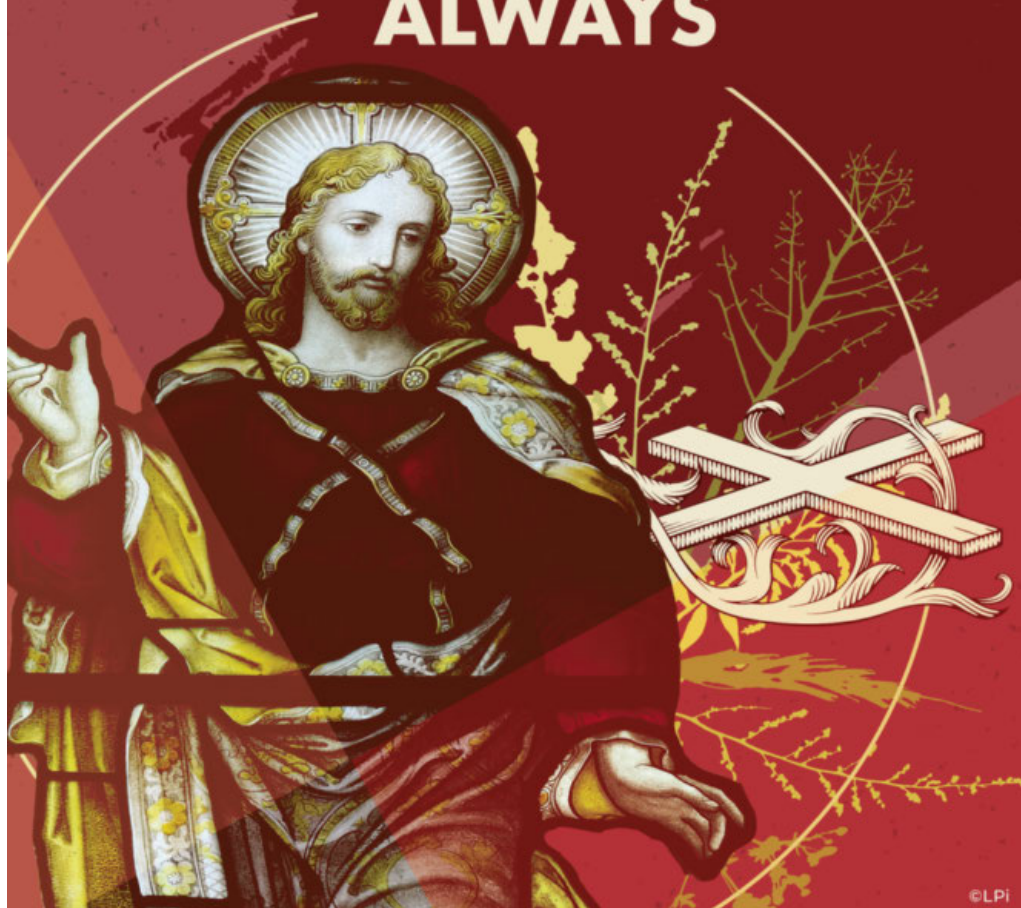

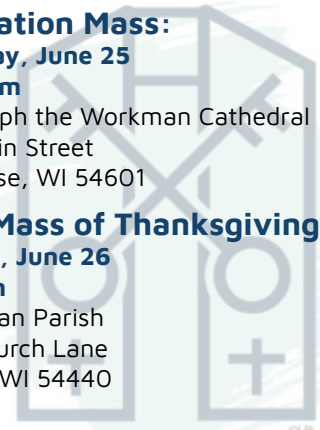

On behalf of all the Christians in St. Joseph's parish, I thank you and all the Christians in your parish for this Donation to our Kindergarten. As soon as we get that money from the Diocese, we will start immediately to order for the chairs and tables since the situation is so bad. The school opened up for the second team on 09.05.2022. The Kindergarten is full but there are new children who turned up and they want to be admitted. There is no more space besides having little chairs and tables.

In the parish a lot has happened:

1. We started a devotion to St. Joseph in addition to constructing St. Joseph's prayer garden which is not yet finished.
2. We baptized 110 children and adults Catechumen on Holy Saturday.
3. We baptized 205 children on Easter Monday.
4. We received 8 Christians back to sacraments.
5. On St. Joseph's day, which is also our Parish day, 194 children received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
6. On the same day, the Bishop opened up the 3rd teacher's house. Thank you so much for your support.
7. He also officially opened up the Kindergarten on St. Joseph's day.

We thank God for protecting you through the Covid time and we pray for those who died during that difficulty time.

Greetings to all our friends in your parish especially to the parish priest. We love all and we pray for you.
