### A MESSAGE FROM FR. JIM...

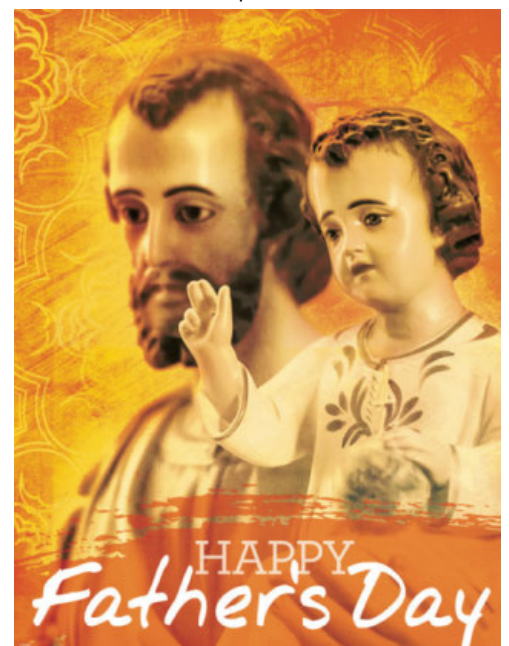

**GÉNESIS 14,18-20; 1 CORINTIOS 11,23-26; LUCAS 9,11B -17**

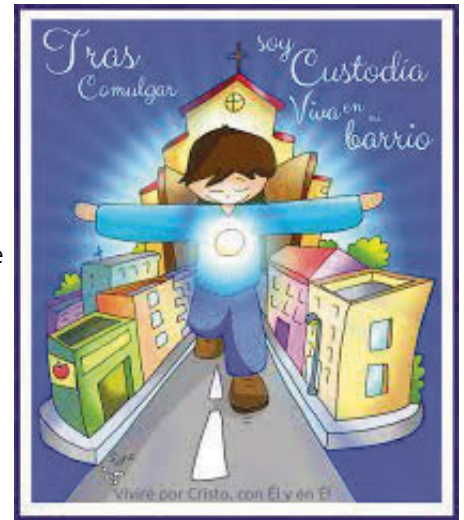

El papa urbano IV estaba por ahí cerca, en Orvieto, población cercana a Bolsena, les pidió que les llevaran las hostias consagradas junto con el corporal, al verlas el papa Urbano IV se arrodilló, mostró el corporal al pueblo ratificando el milagro".
