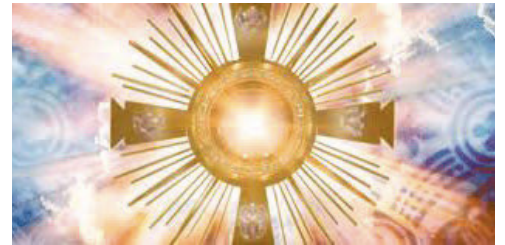

2) As we prepare to celebrate our country's Independence we should all pause for a moment and thank God for the gifts and freedoms we treasure.

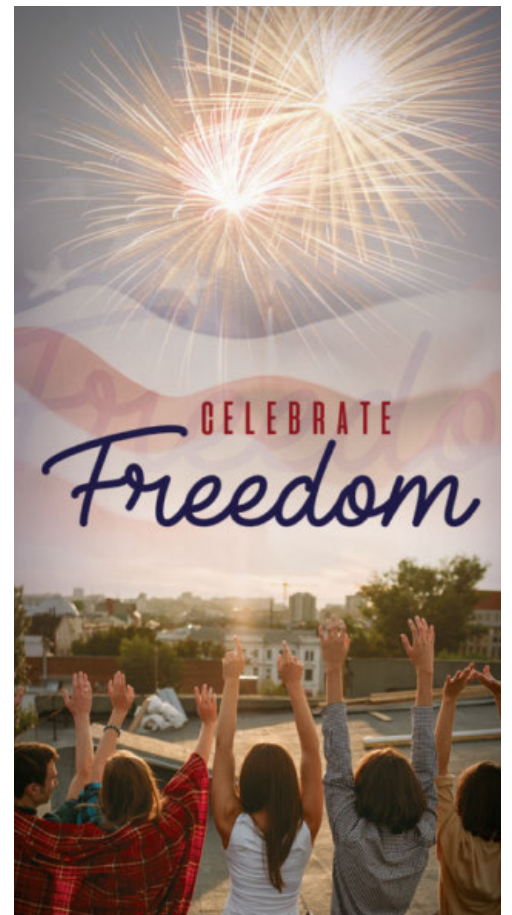
### A PRAYER FOR INDEPENDENCE DAY

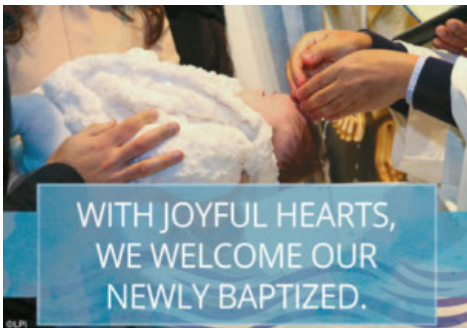

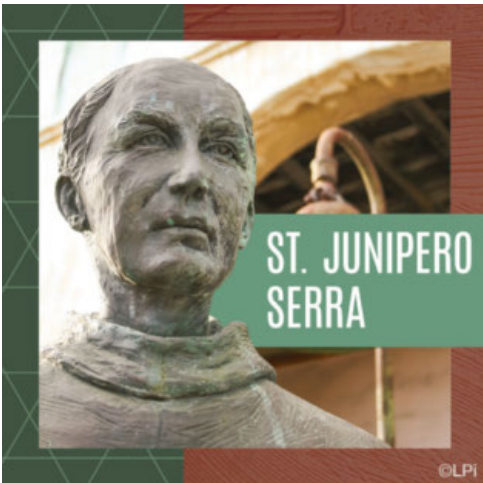

Proclaimed "Venerable" in 1985, and beautified in 1988, by **Pope John Paul II**, his feast day was set in 1989 as July 1. **Pope Francis** canonized **St. Junipero Serra** personally in Washington, D.C. on September 23, 2015, the first-ever canonization on American soil. He is buried at **Mission San Carlos Borromeo**, Carmel, California. "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few." 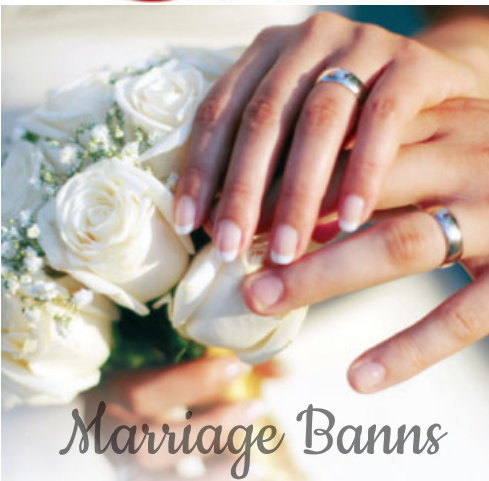
