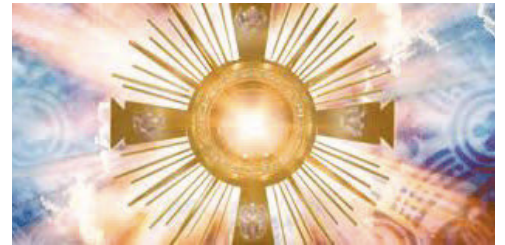

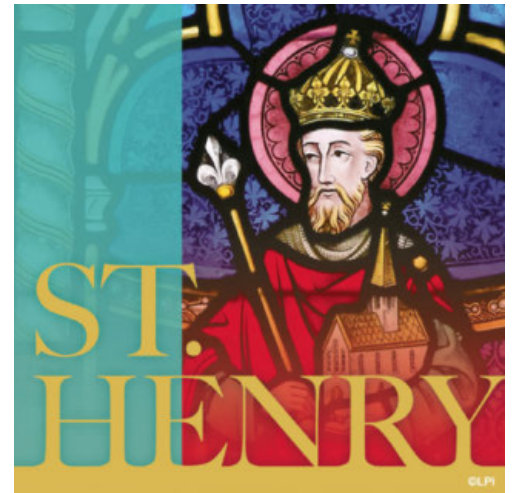

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### St. Henry | July 13

Saint Henry was born in 972 to Henry, Duke of Bavaria, Germany, and his wife Gisela of Burgundy. Saint Henry's early life was permeated with Christianity, among those who guided his education was Bishop Wolfgang of Ratisbon, who became a saint himself. In 995, Saint Henry succeeded his father as Duke of Bavaria, and in 1002, upon the death of his cousin, Otho III, he was elected emperor. In 1014, Saint Henry undertook the long journey from Germany to Rome to be crowned Holy Roman Emperor by Pope Benedict XIII.

In 1022 Saint Henry assisted Pope Benedict VIII in holding the Council of Pavia, which promoted clerical celibacy and sought to end simony (the buying and selling of ecclesiastical goods and offices). During his reign, Saint Henry used his wealth and position for the Church. He confirmed Benedict's authority over Rome, was a patron of churches and monasteries, supported the Cluniac Reforms, restored episcopal sees, and founded the Diocese of Bamberg where he built a cathedral.

Saint Henry died in July of 1024 and was canonized in 1146 by Pope Eugene III.

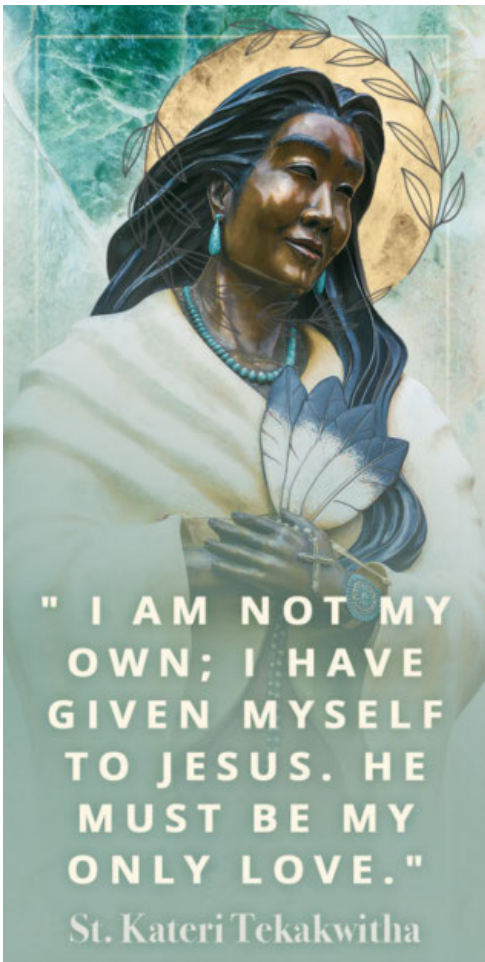

## DOMINGO 15 DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

DEUTERONOMIO 30, 10-14; SALMO 68; COLOSENSES 1, 15-20; LUCAS 10, 25-37

Queridos hermanos hoy el evangelio nos presenta el relato de el buen samaritano ese samaritano que no ve diferencias pero hace la diferencia, el evangelio nos presenta dos acciones en las cuales debemos de meditar:

1. Dio un rodeo y pasó de largo. Hay tantas formas de pasar de largo... Y lo peor es cuando además las enmascaramos con justificaciones «razonables»: «No tengo tiempo», «los pobres engañan», «ya he hecho todo lo que podía...» O peor aún: «hoy día ya no hay pobres». Es exactamente dar un rodeo –aunque sea muy elegante– y pasar de largo. Lo que hicieron el sacerdote y el levita. Y, sin embargo, el pobre es Cristo, que nos espera ahí, que nos sale al encuentro bajo el ropaje del mendigo: «tuve hambre... Estuve enfermo... Estuve en la cárcel».

2. Se compadeció de él. Este es el secreto. El verdadero cristiano tiene entrañas de misericordia. No sólo ayuda: se compadece, se duele del mal del otro, sufre con él, comparte su suerte... Y porque tiene entrañas de misericordia llega hasta el final; no se conforma con los «primeros auxilios».

Y porque tiene entrañas de misericordia lo toma a su cargo, como cosa propia; y eso que era un desconocido, un extranjero –incluso de un país enemigo, pues «los judíos no se trataban con los samaritanos»–.

«Señor, danos entrañas de misericordia ante toda miseria humana».
