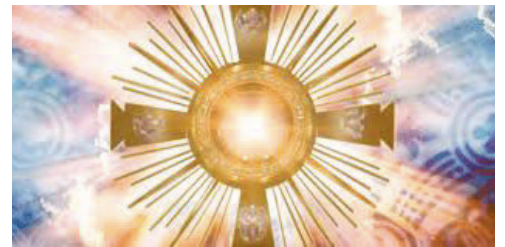

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

A MESSAGE FROM FR. JIM...

MARTHA AND MARY

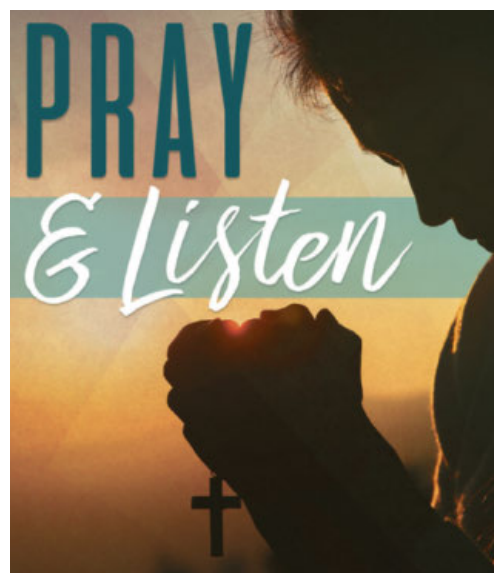
In this Sunday's Gospel we hear about the two famous sisters, Martha and Mary. Has this Gospel reading ever caused a lively discussion in your home? Many people find this reading a hard one to understand. It just seems so unfair. We were taught from little on that it is very impolite to sit and talk with the guests when mom or someone else is in the kitchen all alone doing most of the work. How can Jesus approve of such conduct? He not only defends Mary against her sister's very understandable complaint, but Jesus actually scolds Martha, who is doing her best to get the meal on the table, for being "anxious and upset about many things." How can we possibly make sense out of this episode?

When you stop to think about it the hard-working Martha makes a good point. However, we can never make sense out of this Gospel if we read this story as a lesson in the duties of hospitality. Nor will this story make sense if we don't look at the context in which the story takes place. We have to remember that this episode comes on the tail of last week's Gospel about the Good Samaritan. Jesus emphasized from that story that sometimes we are so worried about the "legal" aspects of our faith we forget to act on our faith - we forget to put our faith into action. Jesus is saying the same thing to Martha. When Jesus said to Martha, "You are anxious and upset about many things", He was not criticizing her for performing the duties of hospitality, but rather for doing so without first attending to His words.

All of us, at times, can be like Martha. We are "anxious and worried about many things." We can't sit still. We can't take time off, as Mary did, to sit quietly in the Lord's presence. Today's story of Martha and Mary makes an important point for us. We can get so involved in what we are doing that we forget why we are doing it. We can get so involved in living that we forget why we are living. It's this kind of mistake that Martha made in today's Gospel. She got so involved in cooking a meal for Jesus that she forgot why Jesus had come. He didn't come for a free meal; He came to be with His friends. I think it's good to have someone come along every once and a while and remind us that we do need to take time for prayer. We do need to take time to listen to the Lord speaking to us in our lives. We do need to take time to reflect on our faith, and examine in what direction our faith is leading us. We all need to have a little bit of both Martha and Mary inside of us.

ST. BRIDGET OF SWEDEN

FEAST DAY | JULY 23

Saint Bridget or Birgitta was born in 1303. She was married to Ulf Gudmarsson, who became governor of the province of Nericia. They had 8 children, all of whom survived past infancy which was rare for the 12th century. One of their daughters would become St. Catherine of Sweden. Saint Bridget was hailed as a mystic & her visions, which began in her early childhood when she had visions of Christ Crucified, made her somewhat of a Middle Ages celebrity. Her vision of the Nativity of Jesus even influenced the art of the Nativity through the Baroque era! She is said to have predicted the Vatican State. Saint Bridget's Revelations, which she dictated to Peter Olafsson, the prior at the Cistercian monastery of Alvastra, were published in 1492. They have since been published in many languages & can still be purchased today. Some of her most profound visions regarded the founding of a new religious order which would be primarily for women, ruled by an abbess, but with a separate house for monks who would serve as order chaplains. Her visions detailed everything from the abbey church to the clothing that would be adopted as the nun's habit, and how the order would be ruled. King Magnus II of Sweden granted Bridget land and buildings. The order, called the Bridgettines or the Order of the Most Holy Savior was approved by Pope Urban V in 1370. Saint Bridget was canonized in 1391 by Pope Boniface IX and in 1999 Pope John Paul II named her one of the Patron Saints of Europe. ©LPi

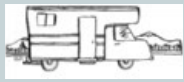

The cost is \$40.00 per day.

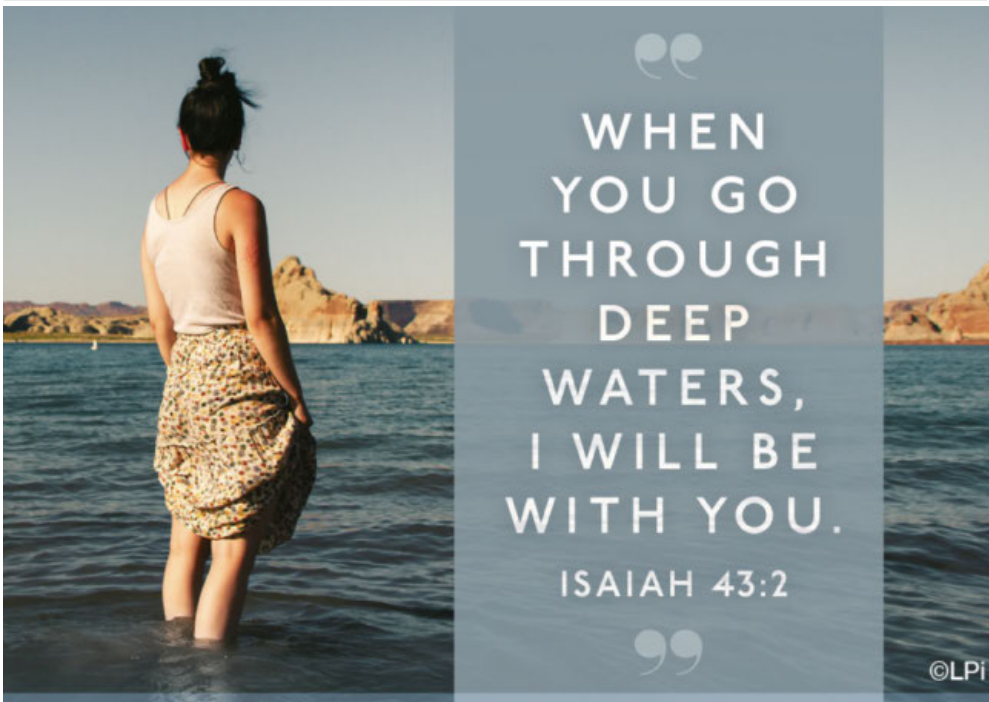
