

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

A MESSAGE FROM FR. JIM...



"What have I done with my life?"

The Scripture readings for this Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time offer us some powerful statements to think about. In the First Reading from the Book of Ecclesiastes: "What profit comes to a person from all the toil and anxiety of heart with which he has labored under the sun?" And in the Second Reading St. Paul says: "Think of what is above, not of what is on earth." And finally, in the Gospel reading Jesus Himself says of the one who decided to tear down his old barns and build bigger ones: "You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you."

"What have I done with my life?" This is the question that we must take to heart in today's liturgy. It's a question that no one else can answer for us. As followers of Jesus Christ, we should be able to answer in such a way that will demonstrate our commitment to our faith. We should be able to answer that we have done our best in this life to set an example for others of what it means to be a Christian and what it means to love God and neighbor. We should be able to answer that in this life we have handed on proper Christian values so that others will act in the ways of Christ. We should be able to answer that we have tried our very best to live out the Gospel that Jesus came to preach. If we can answer the question, "What have I done with my life?" with some of these answers, then our lives here have a purpose and are fruitful.

This is the message of today's readings. It is one of the most important messages the Gospel can set before us for it gets at the heart of everything. It gets at the heart of why we are here: to live in such a way that when we die and Jesus asks us, "What have you done with your life?" we will have something to say. We won't have to turn away in embarrassment... or in regret.




