GOSPEL REFLECTION: FROM DEACON TIM

Two weeks from today is Pentecost. The whole Easter season is building toward that great outpouring of the Spirit. This Sunday's Gospel gives us a precise definition of the love that receives the Spirit. It is not a feeling. It is a fidelity. "If you love me, keep my commandments."

Love is proven by obedience. Jesus doesn't merely ask for feelings. He asks for fidelity. Love without obedience is sentiment. Obedience without love is servitude. Jesus unites both. The Gospel reminds us that love for Jesus leads to action and obedience. This is the fulfillment of the entire moral law. Not a burden imposed from outside, but the natural fruit of a heart transformed by grace.

The Paraclete — Another Advocate. The term comes from a verb meaning "to call to one's side," with background in the Greco-Roman courtroom — a paraclete was someone who could provide help and assistance to a person in a trial setting: give counsel, plead that person's

cause, and intercede with the judge. The Spirit is another Advocate because Jesus Himself is an Advocate with the Father" (1 John 2:1). As the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit serves as a counselor for the disciples. He gives comfort and help when the hostile, unbelieving world persecutes them, and dwelling in the disciples, He leads them to a deeper understanding of Jesus and enables them to bear witness to Him.

"I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you." (John 14:18) The disciples feared abandonment. Christ's answer is not a plan, it is a Person. The Holy Spirit is not a substitute for Jesus; He is the continuing presence of Christ in the soul and in the Church. If the world cannot know the Spirit, and the Spirit lives in you. What might it mean to make the invisible Spirit visible through the way you love today?
