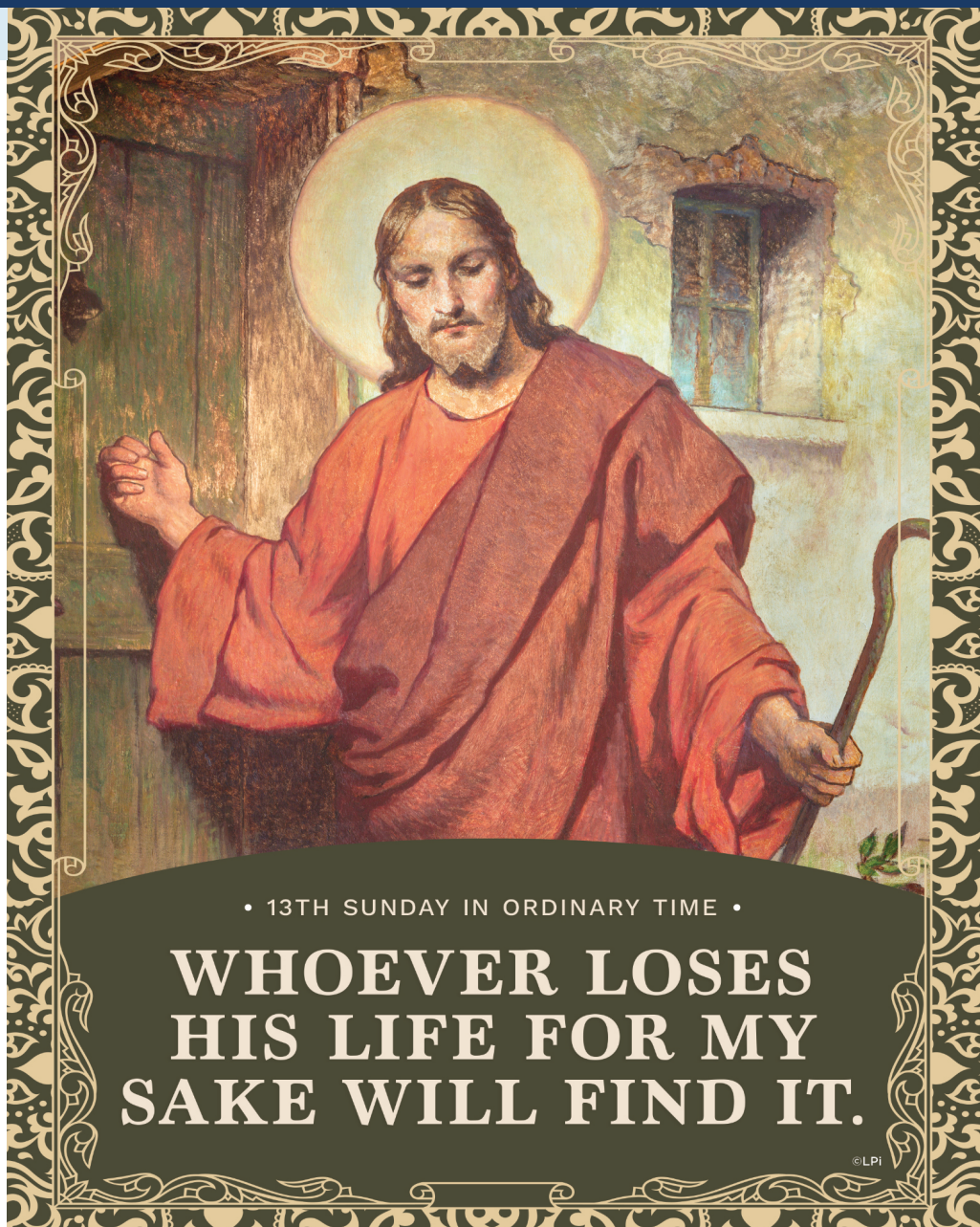

GOSPEL REFLECTION: FROM DEACON RICK

As we look at our Gospel today, we can get stuck on what discipleship is going to cost me. Jesus mentions three things, parents, siblings and our lives. These all seem overwhelming, especially considering in the Jewish faith, family meant everything. Rooted in the Ten Commandments is love of father and mother, and if we focus only on the costs, then things do not seem to make sense. Yet if we look at our first reading we see something different. We see Elisha traveling and being invited to dinner with someone. They develop a friendship and she provides a place for Elisha to stay as he travels, knowing that he is a man of God. Elisha finds out that she has no children and tells her that she will have a son within a year. There is a reward for her caring for and helping Elisha. In our

Gospel Jesus lets us know that there are rewards for following Him, and it is not for doing something huge, but it is for something extremely small. Jesus says, "And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple—amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward." A simple cup of water given to a disciple. St. Mother Teresa is attributed to saying, "Do small things with great love." From that small thing comes great rewards. This week how can we give that cup of water to someone? How can we too be a follower of Jesus?

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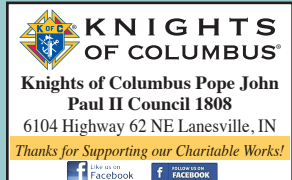
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
