A Minute With Jesus

THE EUCHARIST IS CALLED THE MEMORIAL OF THE LORD'S DEATH AND RESURRECTION



Jesus instructed the Apostles at the Last Supper to "do this in memory of Me." The Eucharist is a memorial, but this means much more than recalling something to mind, or remembering an event from the past. "In Sacred Scripture the memorial is not merely the recollection of past events," but at Mass, they become present and real so that our lives may be conformed to them. "When the Church

celebrates the Eucharist, She commemorates Christ's Passover [Jesus passing over from death to life], and it is made present: the sacrifice of Christ offered once for all on the Cross remains ever present." This week, read how St. Paul describes the Last Supper, capturing Jesus' words: "Do this in remembrance of Me" in 1 Corinthians 11:23-26.

The World Famous Fatima statue is coming to the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish in Marathon on Thursday,




