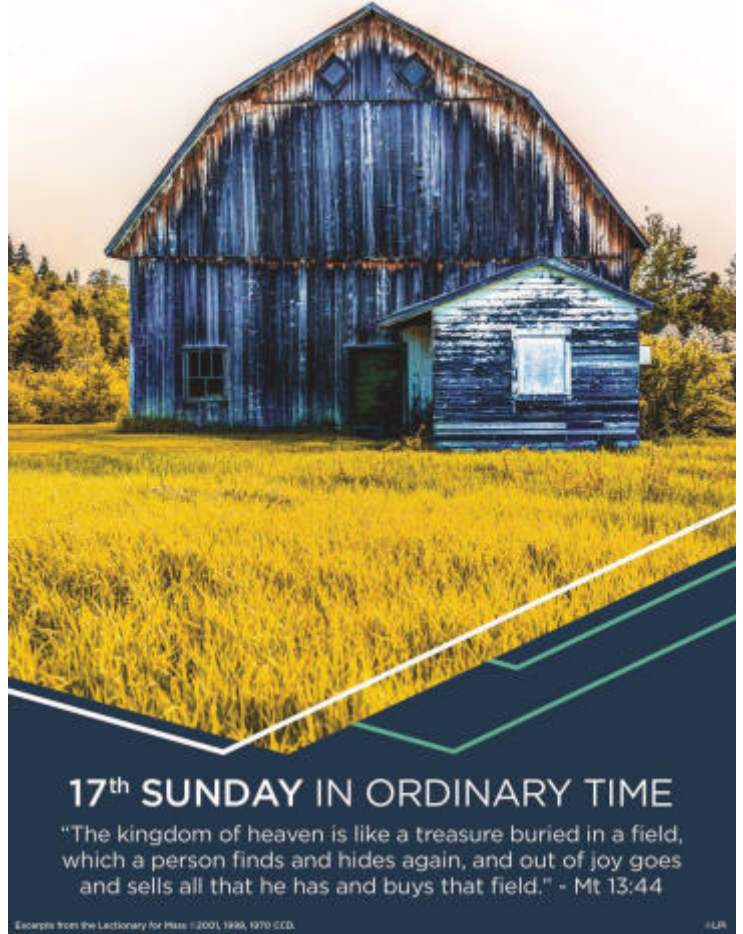

FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK:

As the summer goes along, I'm finding there's less to write about in these weekly writings, but here is a Saint for the week and one idea for how we can continue to grow in our lives of faith throughout these weeks!

Saint Martha: This week, on July 29, we celebrate the memorial of Saint Martha. In the Gospels, she has two "scenes", if you will. One of them: she and her sister, Mary, invited Jesus to their home for dinner. During the course of their time together, Mary sits near Jesus, listening to him teach. Meanwhile, Martha is busy with the household responsibilities of having guest around. Martha complains to Jesus and asks him to make her sister help her with her work. Jesus responds that Mary has "chosen the better part" by being near Jesus and listening carefully to his words. In her other scene with Jesus, when Lazarus dies, Martha begins to confess the truth of the Resurrection to Jesus – recognizing that Jesus is the source of life. Her encounters with Jesus deepened her faith from just doing practical service for Jesus to a profound trust and love for Jesus. How do the practical things of our lives deepen our faith?

Recently, the Governor of Louisiana (who is a practicing Catholic) called for three days of **prayer and fasting** during lunch for an end to the coronavirus and all of its included consequences. It might be surprising to hear such a request from a politician these days! It is not often that we hear politicians recognizing the value of *prayer and fasting* from something good as a response to the challenges of our times. Perhaps, we think of fasting as something that only belongs to Lent, but in truth, the Church suggests us to make fasting a regular part of our lives. Especially on Fridays – to commemorate Jesus' Death on the Cross. Perhaps, in these days of Ordinary Time, we might deny ourselves something that is good to re-remind ourselves that God is the giver of all good gifts. We might skip a lunch during the week or drop out sweets on Friday. This is a good way to remind ourselves that God is control, and He will provide even in the many challenges of our times.
