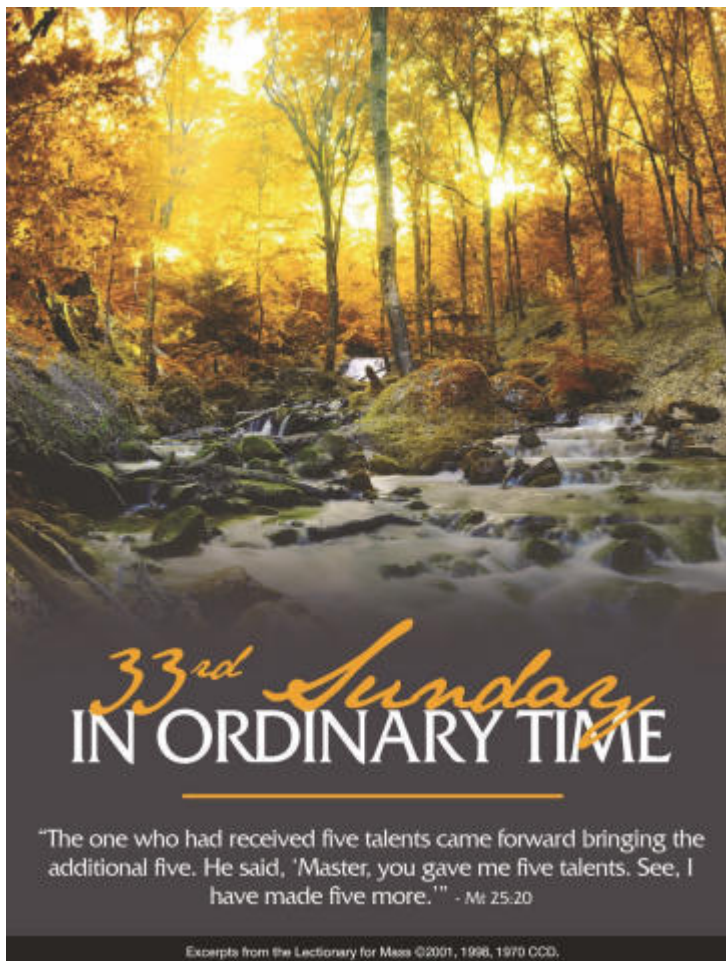

FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK:

On Wednesday, November 18, we celebrate the anniversary of the **Dedication of the Basilicas of Peter and Paul**. Even though it seems odd, we celebrate the "birthday" of these two churches to remind us of the two great Apostles for whom they are named. The original basilicas were built and consecrated in the fourth century. The celebration of their dedications dates back to the twelfth century. About every five years, every bishop throughout the world makes an *ad limina apostolorum* visit to Rome. *Ad limina apostolorum* means to the threshold of the Apostles. Every five years, Bishops are supposed to pray before the tombs of Saints Peter and Paul in these Churches that we celebrate. They also meet with the Pope and give him an update on their local diocese. This celebration of these basilicas' dedication is a powerful reminder about the long, consistent history of the Catholic Church. It also reminds us that our Catholic faith connects us to the Pope and to the Catholic Church not just in our local area – but throughout the world.

(fun side fact: a Wisconsin priest and cardinal, James Cardinal Harvey is the Archpriest of the Papal Basilica of St. Paul, Outside the Walls)

Also on November 18, in the United States, we celebrate **St. Rose Philippine Duchesne**. St. Rose was a French religious sister who came to the US, with the dream of serving Native Americans. She did so with varying success in different parts of Mississippi, Kansas & Missouri. While she was unable to learn the Potawatomi language at the age of 72, they gave her a Potawatomi name that meant "Woman Who Is Always Praying." If we were to fail at everything else, "Person Who Is Always Praying" is not a bad fallback plan.

In the month of November, we continue to pray in a particular way for the **souls of all deceased**. Here are some prayers that you might include during your meal prayer to remember to pray for those loved ones in your own family who have died.

V/. Eternal rest grant unto him/her/them, O Lord.
R/. And let perpetual light shine upon him/her/them.
V/. May he/she/they rest in peace.
R/. Amen.
V/. May his/her/their soul(s) and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
R/. Amen.
