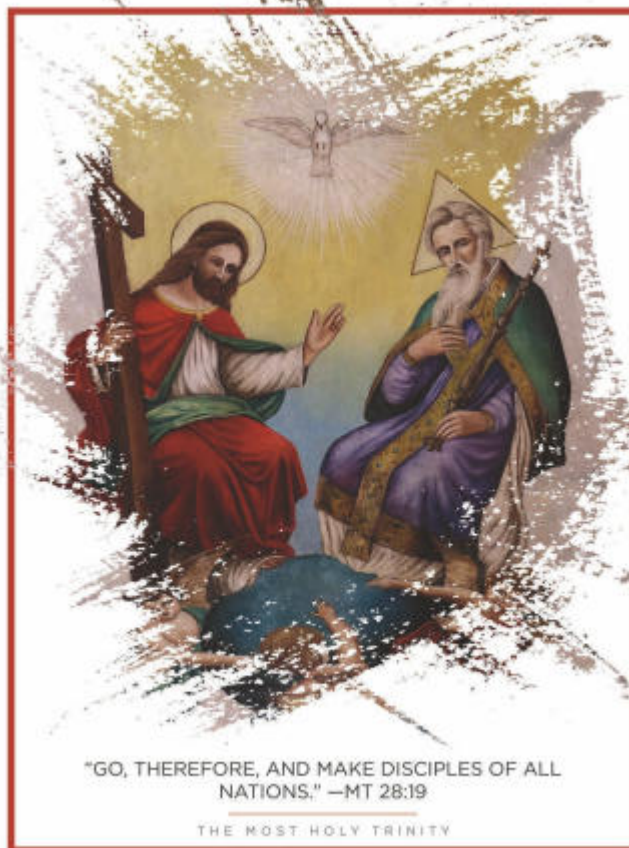

FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK:

Today, we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* says this about the Christian teaching about the Trinity:

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is the source of all the other mysteries of faith... (CCC 234)

In other words, our understanding of the Trinity is central to understanding everything that we believe as Christians – from the Sacraments to marriage and family life to our hope for Heaven when we die. This is why everything in Christian celebrations begins with the Trinity. The Priest or Deacon baptizing a baby says, “I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” We begin almost all of our prayers by calling on God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Even most of the prayers throughout the Mass are directed towards God the Father, through Jesus, his Only Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. If you pay close attention at Mass in the days ahead, you will notice this pattern happening over and over again.

I recently had the privilege of attending the priestly ordination of the three newest and freshest priests of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Later in the weekend, I also assisted at their Masses of Thanksgiving. All of these celebrations were full of joy and festivity! It serves as a good reminder that we should continue to **pray for vocations** to the priesthood from our families. From Saint Peter Parish, we have two men (and soon one more!) in seminary formation. What a great joy if all of our parishes could experience the joy of First Masses every couple years because we have prayed for and supported our sons, grandsons, and godsons to consider a vocation to the priesthood!

To that end, if your son or grandson might be called to the priesthood, I encourage you to invite middle school and high school boys to attend one of the several camps that are held at Saint Francis de Sales Seminary. See below for dates, more information, and how to sign up.
