

FROM THE SHARED PASTOR'S DESK:

- 1. Father's Day Here are some gems to brighten and cheer Dads on Father's Day: "Fathers are people who give their daughters away to other men who aren't nearly good enough so they can have grandchildren smarter than anybody else's." and "A young man wasted his first year and parent's money at college; as a result, he flunked out. Hoping to soften the blow, he texted his Mom: "Flunked out. Prepare Dad." She texted back: "Dad prepared. Prepare yourself!" and "When a young mother had her second little girl, her mother came to help her with the new baby and 14 month old toddler. Once, when both girls were fussing and wet, her husband remarked, "At times like this I think God should have made mothers with four arms," to which his mother-in-law said, "He did, but two of them are on their fathers!"
- 2. St. Aloysius Gonzaga Born into influential, wealthy family and a Renaissance culture familiar with "fraud, dagger, poison and lust," he experienced a profound attraction to living a spiritual life at age 7; by age 11 he was a volunteer catechist to poor children, fasted 3X a week, scourged himself, sought solitude in prayer, and did not look women in the face; these he chose in contradiction to and in protest of the rather extreme licentiousness and permissiveness of the times. When he entered the seminary in the hope of becoming a Jesuit priest missionary, his spiritual director (St. Charles Borromeo) persuaded him to moderate these practices; in 1591, a plague struck Rome and the Jesuits opened a hospital at which their seminarians were volunteers in providing personal services to the sick and dying; he caught the disease, became bedridden, & died at age 23, never to fulfill his earthly vocation due early onset of his heavenly reward. He is the patron of Catholic youth, teens and seminarians; his feast day is June 21; don't forget to say an extra prayer for Isaiah, Nick and Brady!
- 3. The Nativity of John the Baptist On June 24 is one of three birthdays in our liturgical calendar - Our Lord, Our Lady and St. John the Baptist. Normally liturgical commemorations of saints correspond to their dates of death, in reality, their "birthdays" into the life of heaven. When observing a "literal" birthday, the Church is tacitly stating that person was born into this world without Original Sin; hence, Christ and His Mother, conceived without sin; it is a commonly taught understanding that John the Baptist was born without Original Sin, having been freed thereof by the presence of the Lord in His Mother's womb at her Visitation to Elizabeth, John's mother, in view of his preeminent role as the prophet promised to go before the Lord at His coming. The date of this feast recognizes that Elizabeth was said to be six months pregnant when the angel Gabriel told Mary she was to become Jesus' mother, and so procrastinators are duly reminded that it's only six months until Christmas Eve!

Please visit with or call our parish secretaries; the donation per Mass is \$10; as always, these arrangements are on a first-come, firstserved basis, so, if you have special needs or plans, please anticipate! Some ask about "multiple intentions" on Sunday weekends: this is only possible when all weekday intentions are filled and with consent from those who may have arranged their intention prior.
