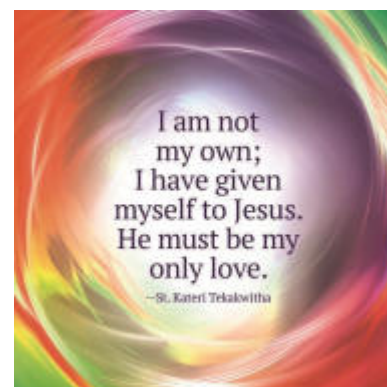
FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR’S DESK:

VIRTUES – Part 3 – Here, I will continue this little series on the virtues. The briefest of refreshers so far: A virtue is a habit and disposition of choosing well and making good decisions. Developing virtues in our life helps us to live a good life, to be happy, and (hopefully and eventually) to be like God in Heaven forever. The cardinal virtues are the first ‘category’ of virtues; they include: prudence, justice, fortitude and temperance. You can see the bulletin on June 27 to read about prudence; in this bulletin I will focus on the virtue of **justice**.

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* describes justice as the virtue that ‘consists in the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbor.’ In other words, justice is the habit of giving God and every human person what is appropriately theirs, or that they ought to have. The Church is deeply concerned about ‘social justice.’ In our contemporary world, this phrase is fraught with misunderstanding. What it should mean for us is that Christians care about other humans’ basic needs. Christians help to provide for others’ food, water, shelter, basic education and healthcare needs, etc. From the first days of the Church, Christians provided for the poor and marginalized. In the course of time, religious orders provided enormous aid to those without food or shelter, education through schools and universities, and healthcare through early and modern day hospitals. Becoming people who are just helps us to use our strengths, talents, and gifts to help other people – each in our own way.

On July 14, we celebrate the Memorial of **Saint Kateri Tekakwitha**. She was born in 1656 to an Iroquois father and Algonquin Christian mother. She was a woman of deep prayer, purity, and love for Jesus. She is part of the “24 club” – a number of wonderful saints who died at the age of 24 – and yet made a huge impact on the memory and imagination of how to live a Christian life. Some other members of the “24 club” include Sts. Therese of Lisieux and Aloysius Gonzaga, and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. These young saints remind us that we are *never* too young or too old to become a saint, to make a difference in the world, and to help lead other people to Jesus.

July 16 is the celebration of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**. Among the many titles and celebrations of Mary, this one commemorates when she gave the brown scapular to St. Simon Stock as a reminder of our Lady’s love and prayers for us, her children. Wearing a scapular every day can be a powerful reminder to us to pray the Rosary and ask for Mary’s prayers and assistance in our daily lives. We should also pray for the Carmelites priests and friars at Holy Hill who foster and maintain a place of pilgrimage and prayer for so many of us in the area.

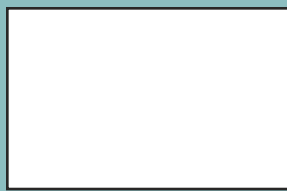

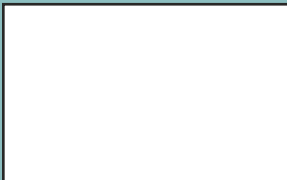

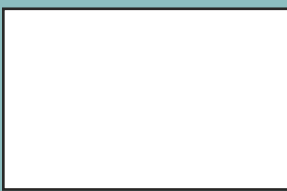
