FROM THE SHARED ASSOCIATE PASTOR'S DESK:

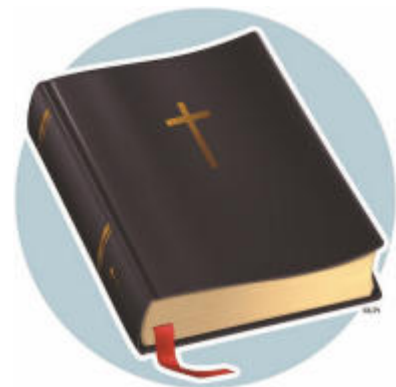
Today Saint Lawrence is celebrating our patronal feast and our 175th anniversary! We rejoice in the good works God has done throughout these many years of baptizing, forming, feeding, educating and burying disciples and friends of Jesus. For all of our parishes, this great celebration is a reminder for us of God's enduring love. Think of how much the world, our communities, and our family life have changed in the course of the many years. Yet, Jesus remains the same. Day in and day out, He still feeds us with His Body and Blood in the Eucharist. He still claims us from the hand of sin and slavery in Baptism and Reconciliation. He still brings us close to Himself during suffering, illness or death. He still leads us to life with Him. We pray for all the families who have given their blood, sweat and tears to our parish to help proclaim the Name of Jesus! Thank you to all who have made the celebrations today possible!

VIRTUES – Part 5. We continue this series of articles about the virtues and how to live a good life. This Sunday we focus on the moral virtue of **temperance**. I will quote at length from the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* because it summarizes this virtue well:

“Temperance is the moral virtue that moderates the attraction of pleasures and provides balance in the use of created goods. It ensures the will's mastery over instincts and keeps desires within the limits of what is honorable.” (CCC 1809)

In other words, temperance is the habit to use worldly and earthly things appropriately. A simple example might be the consumption of food (which parallels Fr Rick's bulletin from last Sunday). If we never eat and never enjoy a good meal, we will be hungry, do our daily tasks poorly, and do damage to our health. If we are always eating, never saying 'no' to more frozen custard, we will easily grow heavier and less and less healthy. The virtue of temperance helps us to recognize that the world – made by God – is good and can therefore be enjoyed. On the other hand, we should not overuse and abuse the gifts that God has given us in this world. You can refer to Fr Rick's bulletin for some practical ways that we might consider practicing and developing this good virtue of temperance.

Homework – As you may know, at the end of Mass, I have been assigning little 'homework' assignments to help us pay attention to Jesus teaching us about the Eucharist over the course of a couple of weeks. This week's 'homework': Read through headlines of John's Gospel, chapter 6. Ask God to draw your attention to anything He wants you to see or read.
