### From Fr. Godfrey

As we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we have opportunity to focus on the glory that God has in store for us: Mary was assumed body and soul into heaven, where she is Queen of Heaven and Earth. When Christ comes again, we look forward to that glorious union of body and

soul as well. I have always marveled at our Blessed Mother Mary's docility to the will of God. Instead of claiming her will, going her own way, she graciously, faithfully, sacrificially does what God wants. So often in our day, God's will doesn't seem to enter into our hearts and minds all the time. We can be far more set on getting and requiring what we prefer, rather than ever entertaining the questions of our lives from God's perspective: the good of all His beloved sons and daughters. In wisdom that has persevered for 1,500 years, Saint Benedict teaches us an important lesson in Chapter 1 of the Rule. *The third kind is the sarabaites, the most detestable monastics, who have been tested by no rule under the hand of a master "as gold is tested in fire" but have a nature soft as lead. Still keeping faith with the world by their works, they lie to God by their tonsure (monastic haircut). Living in twos and threes or even singly, without a shepherd, they are enclosed not in God's sheepfold but in their own. Their law is the gratification of their desires because whatever they believe and choose to do they call holy, but what they dislike they consider forbidden.* In simpler language: sarabaites are governed by their own desires and preferences, not by the love or will of God. So much of what we all do at St. Benedict Cathedral shows that we are attentive to the will of God. We work toward charity, gentleness, compassion. In our day, we have a powerful witness to offer in kindness, in Christian love, in true discipleship that allows each other's best interest to be always at heart.

Vocations culture takes time to build. It also takes a village. Three years ago, Bishop Joseph Siegel opened the Father Deydier House of Discernment at Sacred Heart Church. *Would guys come? Would the people support it?* It seemed as though the Holy Spirit was moving our Church in a more intentional direction for tending to priestly vocations, but this was still only the ‘planting’ phase. “Harvest”? It wasn’t on the horizon.

This summer has shown so profoundly the seedlings that have sprouted and are growing in vocations for our diocese. Not only did the House year close as two residents moved into the seminary, but so many programs and events in June and July are supplying ample hope that the Spirit is indeed moving in this work.

More than 50 young men have stayed in the St. Joseph’s Attic, blessed on May 1. These guys range from middle school students through college seminarians. Many of them might one day be your parish priests.




