St. James Early Childhood Update

The school year is winding to a close. It's been a strange year teaching in early childhood, making sure that 3-5 year olds are socially distanced as much as they can be, sanitizing constantly, teaching in a mask for eight hours, and daily cleaning of tables, chairs, etc. Despite these obstacles, the 22 students in our St. James program have thrived.

Eight of our students are graduating from our program and going off to kindergarten, four of our students are joining their siblings at their schools, one student has been accepted into a gifted program, nine of our students are returning, and we have accepted four new students for the 2021-22 school year. We love giving tours and talking about our program here at St. James! With a flexible schedule, students can attend as little as three half days or as much as five full days. If your child has never been in a program before, our three half days are a great starting point to get them adjusted to the classroom routine and learn how to socialize with others.

We have an amazing facility with room to grow. Some of our special classrooms are:

- a small group room where we pull different ages for small group time so they can learn according to their level.
- a gross motor room where the students are inspired to play and move.
- a library where the students go for story time with special guest readers, or just some quiet time to spend with books.

Our students learn through play. Here's how our new director, Mrs. Toni Gissy, describes our program: "Our daily schedule consists of a whole group, small group and independently conducted activities. The children explore, manipulate, investigate, and discover through participating in lessons and activities in language/literacy, math, music, art, dramatic play, and fine/gross motor skills.

Our preschool curriculum is designed to prepare students for kindergarten and correlates to the Unified Archdiocesan Curriculum. Our multi-sensory curriculum is a hands-on approach that meets the whole child. Through Learning without Tears and Calendar Math, we use specialized materials for academic growth and early childhood skills."

We want to thank Mrs. Angela White, Ms. Melissa Strohmeyer, and Mr. Ed Bozesky, along with our volunteers, Sr. Carissa and Ms. Betty Halley, for making this program a place where children feel comfortable, and helping them to learn and grow.

In June, Mrs. White, Ms. Melissa, and Mrs. Gissy will be concentrating on deep cleaning our space and preparing for our annual fire, sanitation and childcare inspection by the Department of Health and Senior Services. They will also inventory and rearrange some of the space.
