

A Pastor's Reflection by Fr. Quirk, Ph.D.



Dear Parishioners,

Today is the official Feast Day of the apostle: St. James the Greater. This parish is named in his honor. As such, it is fitting that we remember him on this day. He took to heart his calling by Jesus

and worked to witness to his calling and belief in Jesus. He is particularly remembered for his efforts in Spain. There has, of course, developed since his days a "cultural" musical relationship between Irish music and Spain's traditional music roots.

Below is a reflection from the Little Sister's of the Poor Magazine. Today is World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly. Pope Francis in his great love for family life has designated the last Sunday of July as the Church's liturgical day to invoke prayers and blessings for grandparents and the elderly.

As Little Sisters we are intensely aware of the burdens borne by the elderly during the Coronavirus pandemic. At the same time, the faithfulness of our staff members and the generosity of our benefactors, both old and new, have given us eloquent proof that the elderly have not been completely forgotten, even though they have been hidden away for over a year. As vaccination rates rise the urgent fears surrounding COVID-19 seem to be dissipating, and we are witnessing a growing commitment on the part of many to responding more holistically to the needs and aspirations of older persons.

As he has done throughout his pontificate, Pope Francis continues to demonstrate a preferential option for the elderly. Earlier this year he announced the establishment of a World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly, which will be held each year on the fourth Sunday of July. This date was chosen because of its proximity to the feast of St. Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. We Little Sisters were filled with joy at this announcement - God knows how much the elderly deserve a celebration dedicated to them!

To express the closeness of God and of the Church to every older person, Pope Francis has chosen "I am with you always," from the Gospel of Matthew, as the theme for the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.


