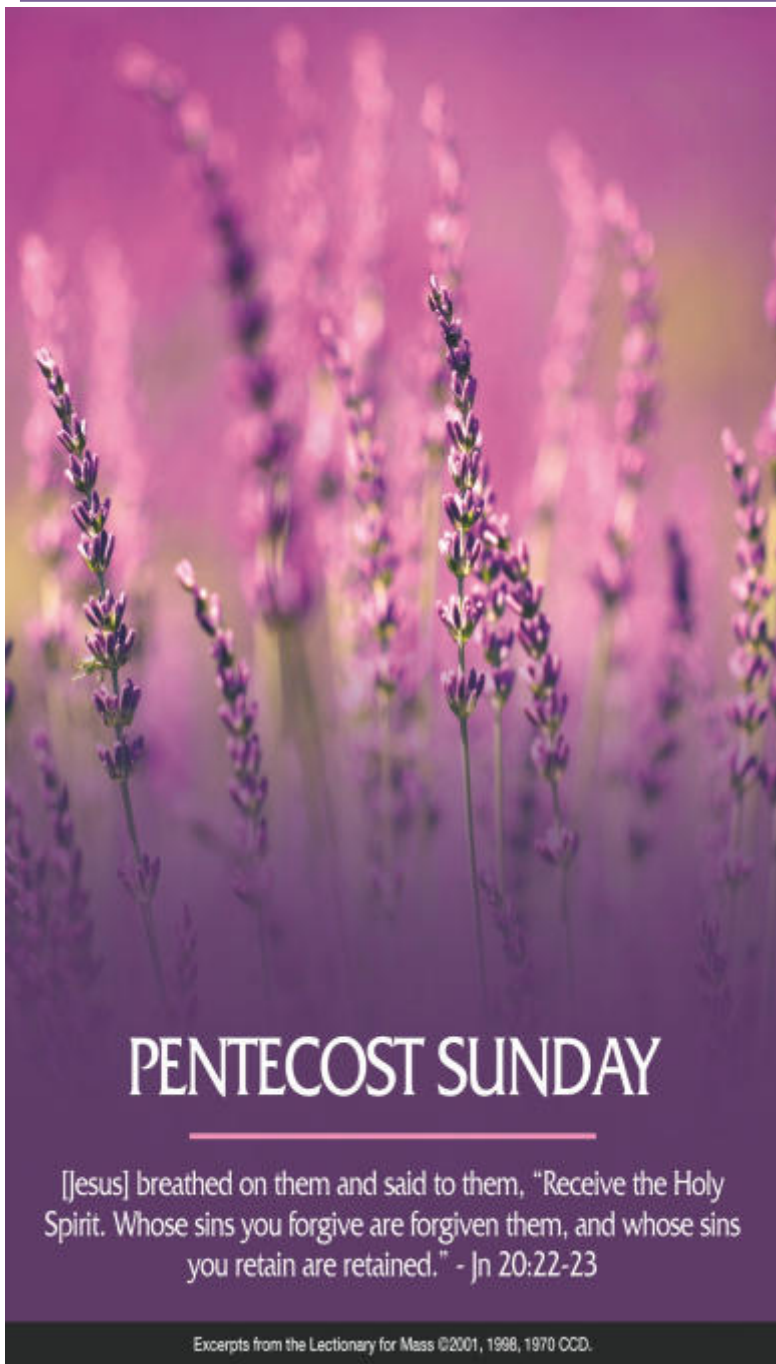

RENE was a Catholic priest who worked with the deaf for many years. A man Fr. Rene was trying to help murdered him in 2016. You will feel amazed watching this movie. Pentecost Sunday, Cycle C—Jesus appears to his disciples and gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Family Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the Church. The Gospel for Pentecost reminds us that the church begins with the command to forgive. Within the family, the domestic Church, we learn how to forgive, and we learn to accept forgiveness. It is the gift of the Holy Spirit that enables us to do both. Today is a fitting time to share a family celebration of reconciliation.

Family Connection As you gather together as a family, sit quietly for a few minutes, inviting all to reflect upon their need to forgive and to receive forgiveness. If there is a situation or issue within the family that needs attention, spend some time reflecting upon the concern and how your family might address it. Read together today's Gospel, John 20:19-23. Talk together about how Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us in the work of forgiveness and to bring us peace. Pray together today's psalm, or the Prayer to the Holy Spirit, asking that the Holy Spirit help your family. Share with one another the sign of peace.
