- ◆ PLEASE make sure you pick up your Church envelopes. Your weekly donations keep St. Francis Borgia parish open for the deaf community. There are VERY few Catholic Deaf Centers like St. Francis Borgia open in the world.
- ◆ CCAC (Chicago Children's Advocacy Center) cares for over 2,000 children who suffer sexual abuse in Chicago every year. They sent us the following note, "Thank you to all the people in your community. They donated so many wonderful, warm clothes. Many of these children cannot return home; that is where they were abused. YOUR gifts of beautiful, warm clothes made these children feel so happy."
- ◆ SHOES: bring your nice, but used/new shoes to St. Francis Borgia on Sundays. Give them to Jimmy Smith. We will donate them to raise funds for Children of Peace/Holy Trinity school.

### Message from Margaret Swatek, Religious Education Reporter **Feast of the Baptism of the Lord**

The baptism of Jesus is another epiphany, a moment of revelation. In this baptism, the Trinity is revealed (the voice of God, the Father, the person of Jesus Christ, and the dove). Jesus' baptism opens the door for all of us to participate in the life of God. We have been called to the same baptismal waters. In Baptism, we receive a new life in Christ - we put on Christ, like a garment - and are made into sons and daughters of God, in whom he is well pleased.

Share memories of your family members' Baptisms. Show pictures or videos, candles and baptismal garments. Ask your children what they think it means to be a son or daughter of God. Add an icon of the baptism of Jesus to your prayer table. Read this Gospel again as the family looks upon the image and discuss how Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are represented.

As the new year begins, the Church is still celebrating the birth of Jesus. Churches are filled with the beautiful and rich decorations of Christmas. For the feast of Epiphany of the (January 5), and for the feast of the Baptism of the Lord (January 12), the priest's vestments are still the white or gold of the Christmas season. But the feast of the Baptism of the Lord is the last day of the Christmas season. On January 13, Ordinary Time begins. Green is the color we see in our churches as the Gospels help us grow in our knowledge and understanding of Jesus' mission.

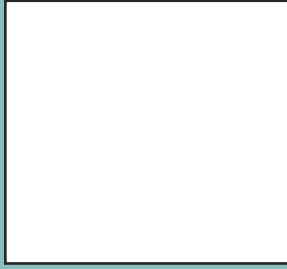
