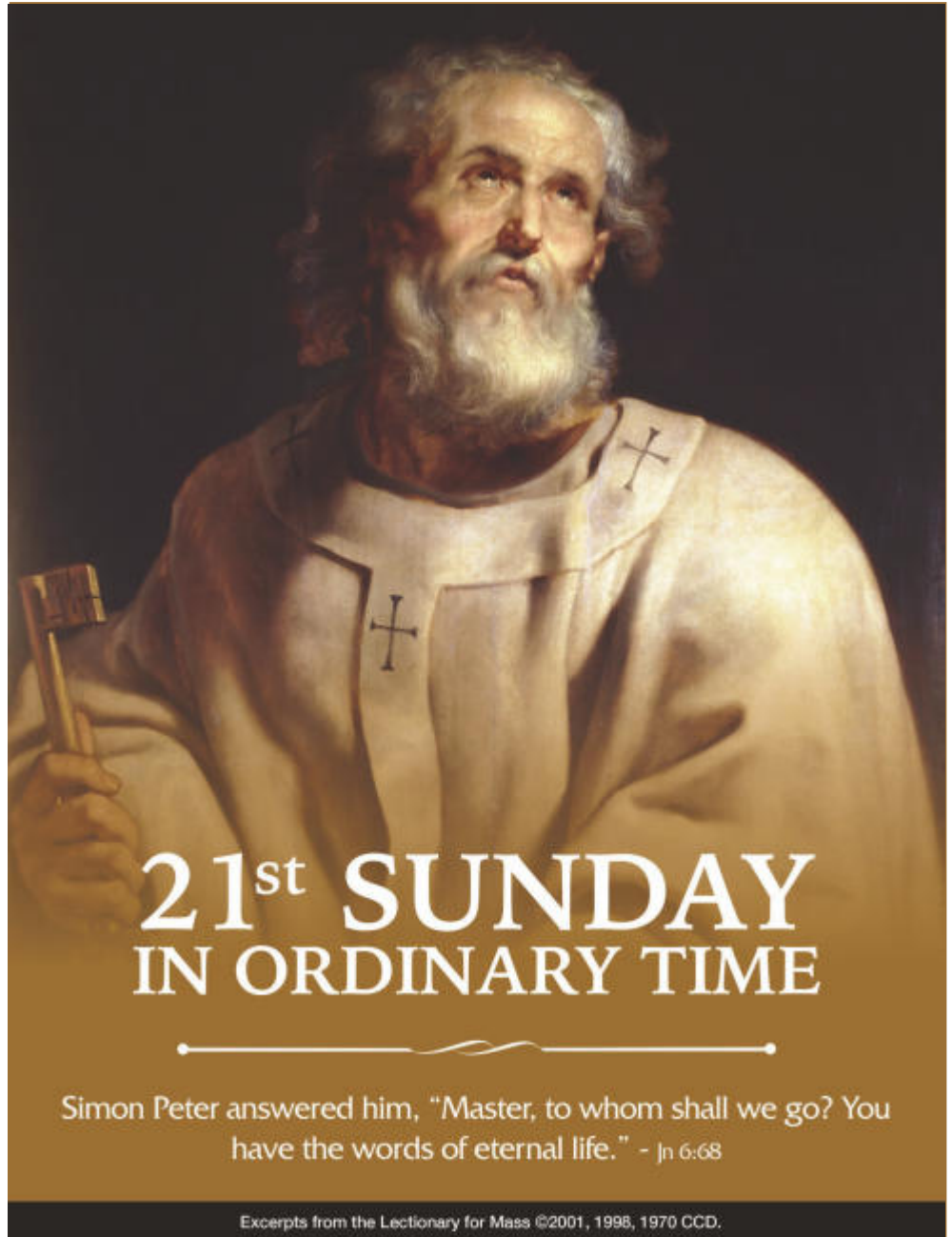

## A LETTER FROM THE MUSIC DESK

### FAMILY OF FAITH,



As you can imagine this has been an odd first year for one to come into the role of Director of Music amid COVID and all of the restrictions placed on singing that came along with the pandemic. That being said, I am very excited to be back at IHM having grown up in this parish being that it is my home parish. I look forward to building upon what we have

established in the past year following the doctrine of the church as it pertains to sacred music. I am mostly excited because we have the opportunity to bring back choral singing this fall which is one aspect of sacred music that we have not been able to get much traction on due to those restrictions on singing. This is an important step towards normalcy as it pertains to the liturgy as the role of the choir is one that is strongly supported in the most important documents of the church including Musica Sacram and Sing to the Lord. The Second Vatican Council stated emphatically that choirs must be diligently promoted while ensuring that "the whole body of the faithful may be able to contribute that active participation which is rightly theirs, as quoted from Sing to the Lord.

With this I am asking each and every parishioner to prayerfully consider with an open heart participating in the Adult Choir here at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish. The choir is the backbone of every successful parish music program. It is integral to the celebration of Holy Mass. It is also of the upmost importance that the choir be rather robust so that it may sing all of the vast repertoire that exists for sacred liturgies. There is no such thing as too many people when it comes to a choir!

The primary role of the choir is to pray the Mass. The choir sings the Mass just as the priest celebrates the Mass. Sacred Music is part of the liturgy and the role of the choir is to pray them through singing. Leading others to pray is the secondary role and it only happens when the choir members themselves are praying. God should be the center of the liturgy. We are Catholic first and musicians second. The ultimate goal of a choir is to praise and glory God by singing and praying well. The choir will sing the Mass Ordinary Kyrie, Gloria, Psalm, Alleluia, Agnus Dei, in alternatum or alternating with the congregation. This is a common practice in the Catholic Church and is a way in which we can elevate our liturgy in efforts to reach closer to God and the choir of angels.

The choir will rehearse Wednesday nights at 7:00pm beginning on September 8th. The choir's first Mass will be September 19th at the 10:15 Mass. Additionally, the Adult Choir will be joined by the youth choir at one Mass a month. The two choirs will share in the singing of the Mass together. We will be holding a sign up for several weeks upcoming. Please stop by the back of the church and introduce yourself and I will be pleased to meet you and help get you signed up!

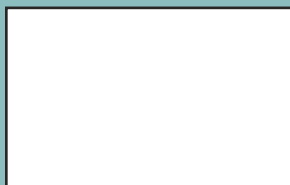
