The Joy of Easter and a Few Facts

The Season of Easter is a special time for each of us to engage more completely in the Joy of the Resurrection. Our Lord Has Risen! He has risen, indeed!

The Season of Lent, which at 40 days is less than the 50 days of Easter, highlighted the spiritual practices of prayer, almsgiving and fasting. The lessons we learned from our Lenten journey pave the way for a bountiful Easter Season.

Last week (and in the previous bulletin), I highlighted the importance of lifelong learning. It is a reality that the local Church and this parish places an emphasis upon the catechesis of our young people. Indeed, our sacramental preparation program, led by Maureen Rogg, and St. Michael's youth ministry, led by Aaron Frazita, is among the best in the Archdiocese!

Our more mature parishioners are very much engaged in fraternal (Knights of Columbus); spiritual (daily Mass); and service activities.

But I have often reflected upon this question: what about the needs, interests and desires of those between 18 and 50 (to select one age range)? What does or should St. Michael's offer these parishioners, also the future of our Church, by way of opportunities for spiritual growth, outside of weekend Mass?

There is a good body of research suggesting that even those who are products of the elementary and high school Catholic educational system experience a disconnection with the Church. Marriage and/or baptisms may be the first point of connection for many of our 20- and 30-somethings following high school or college graduation.

With the average age at the time of marriage now being in the late 20s, this can effectively mean that, for many, at least a decade elapses before reengagement with the Catholic Church.

Many folks cohabit today. A majority of all babies are born to single mothers. I receive requests, on almost a daily basis, to pray for children/siblings/other adults to "return to the Church."

Each of these facts is a reality. The challenge for us is in reconnecting our younger people as well as older adults with the Faith.

They are usually going to ask for gift-cards if you respond to them. Please make sure that you are looking at who the sender of any email is before replying. Any email you receive that does not end with @stmichaellouisville.org, did not come from anyone from St. Michael Church or school.

These types of emails usually start with an immediate need for a response. "Hey, do you have a minute?" "Could you do something for me please?"

Father Steven will never contact you asking for gift-cards, money, codes, wire transfers or crypto-currency. If you receive a text or email from someone pretending to be Father Steven, please disregard it.



Groundbreaking Crosier/Shovel

On a glorious fall day on September 29, 2011 the church community of St. Michael's gathered for the groundbreaking of our new church! Archbishop Kurtz was present to bless the beginning construction of our new church. Bill Greenwell, parishioner, and a woodworking specialist, volunteered to make a crosier (a staff resembling a shepherd's crook, that was carried by the Archbishop). At the bottom of the crosier, Bill attached a shovel to assist in the groundbreaking, (see picture). This crosier is still with us, currently is kept in the Parish Office.

Assisting the Archbishop in turning over the "first soil" were our former pastors, our current pastor, and our two deacons. Also invited were the oldest founding members of our parish Mr. & Mrs. Jay and Francis Moran (see picture).

Because the church was going to be constructed in our current parking lot, the construction crew brought over a couple of scoops of dirt to the parking lot so the groundbreaking could take place.

There was a lot of confusion with the congregation on where the new church was going to sit on the property. To help with the confusion, plans of the new building were marked with spray paint to highlight the outer walls of the new church. To mark the location of the main altar, a red rectangle was painted on the blacktop (see picture). It can be seen at the entrance to the parking lot!

Construction was completed, and our new church was dedicated on June 16, 2013.


