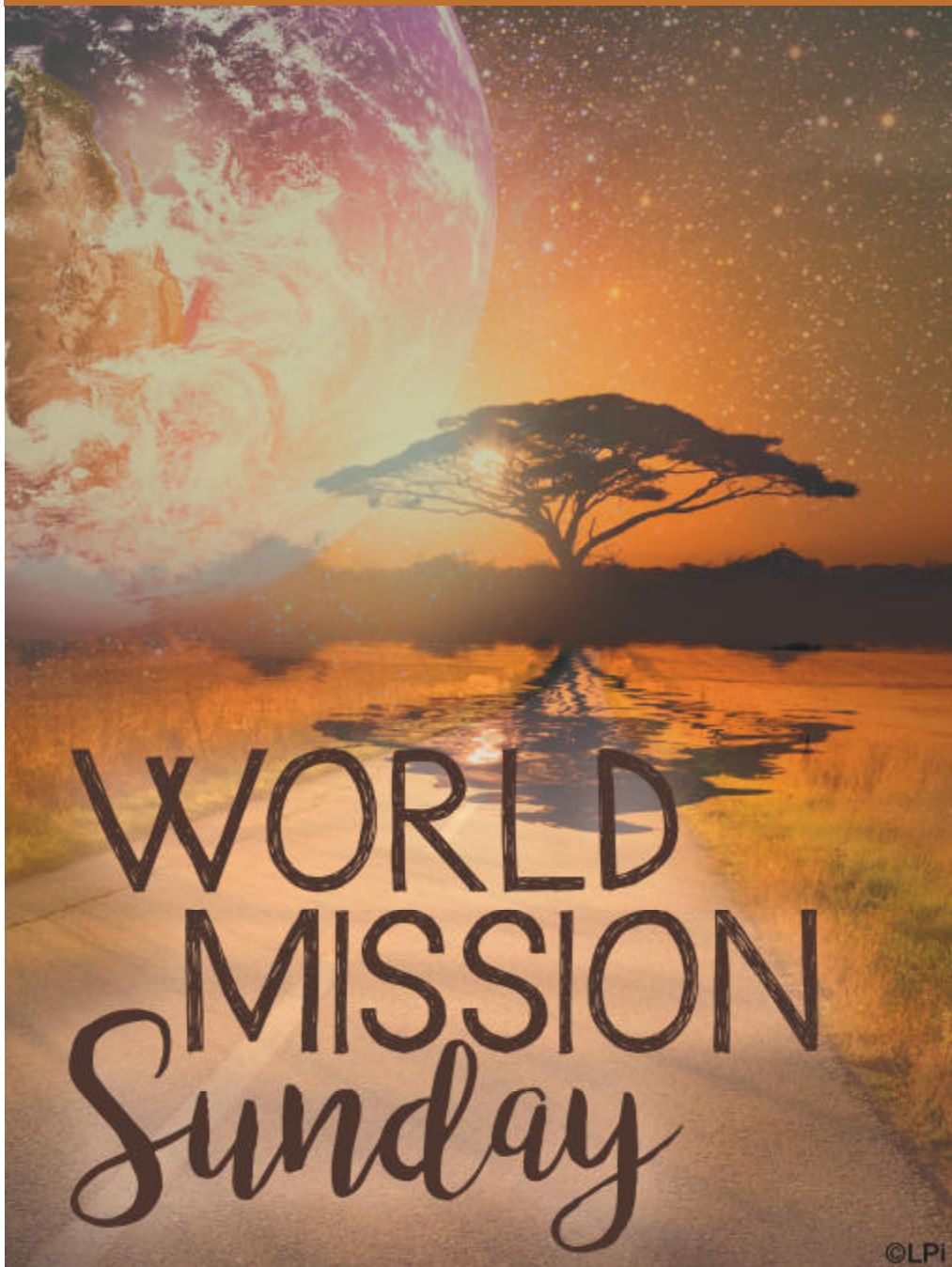

DIGITAL PHONE CALLING CHANGE

Beginning on October 24, 2021, the FCC has ruled that you must dial ten digits (area code + telephone number) for all local calls, even if the number you are calling is in your same area code. On and after this date, local calls dialed with only seven digits may not connect, and a recording will inform you that your call cannot be completed as dialed. You must hang up and dial again using the area code and the seven-digit number. Transitioning to ten-digit dialing will not affect your current telephone number. Your phone number, including your area code, will not change.

Because of this encounter with Jesus, his insight is richer.

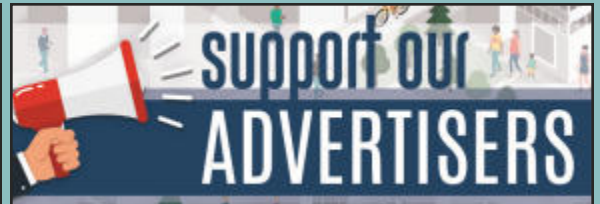
