

VOCATION CORNER:

What a wonderful Gospel account of the Magi traveling to meet the Lord. They followed the star - their "call" - to come and offer their gifts to the Lord. But the question arises as to how the Magi noticed a star at night and no one else really did. Perhaps we need to embrace the "night", the stillness, to "see and hear" our call. How are we doing in discerning our call to Holiness - in living our vocation as man, woman or child; married or single; priesthood or religious - of being called to something beyond ourselves?
