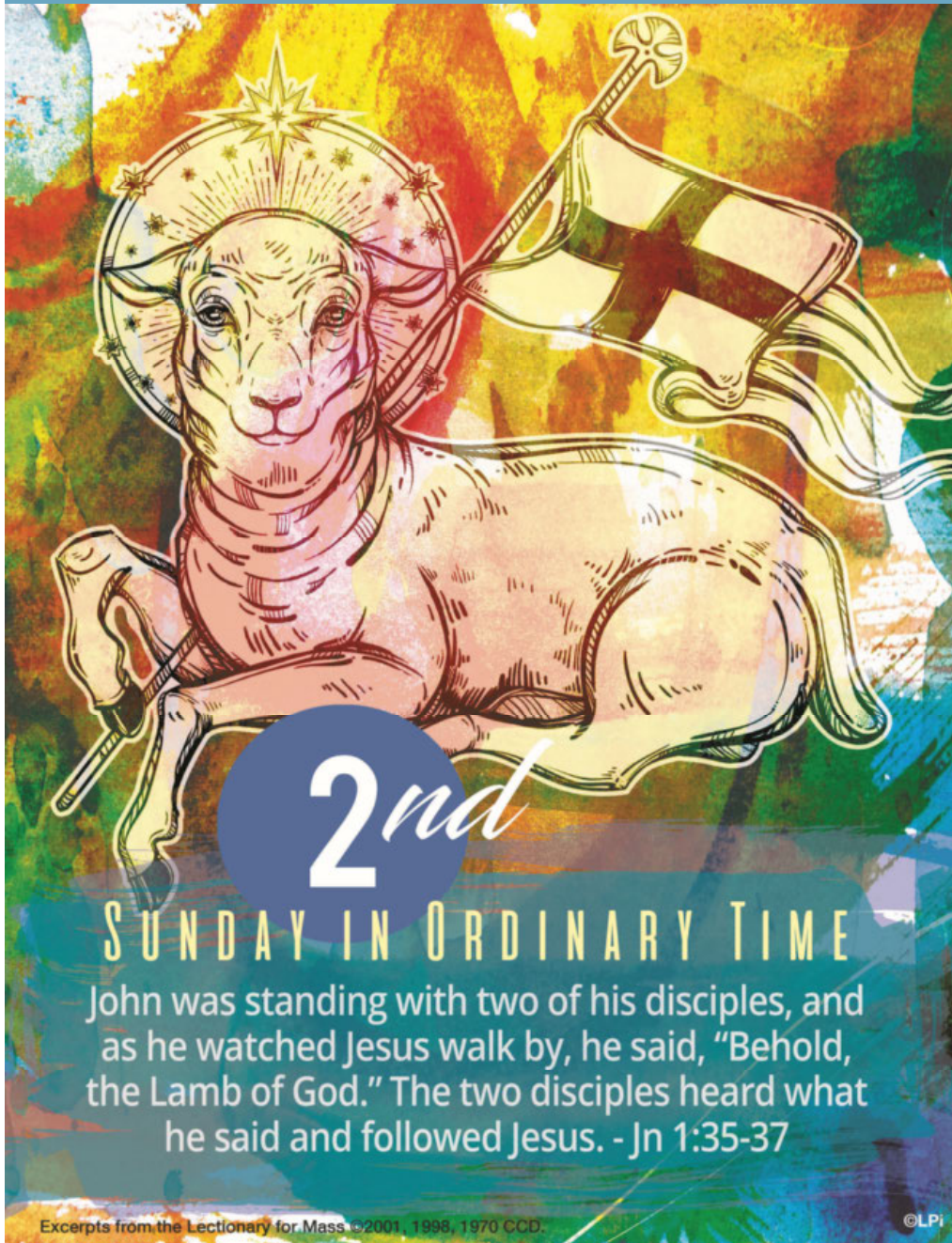

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parish Family of St. Augustine,

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: With the conclusion of the Christmas Season last Sunday, we have returned to a brief period of "Ordinary Time". This "ordinary" Season invites us to continue our reflection on the gift of Jesus as Savior and Light of the world. Another "manifestation" of Jesus as Savior is the Gospel account of the wedding feast at Cana. At the request of the Blessed Mother, Jesus recognizes that it is the Father's will that He begin His public ministry with a miracle for the wedding couple that have run out of wine at their wedding celebration. Besides the charity of Our Lord for the couple, the miracle reveals that Jesus Himself is "good wine" saved "until now"...He is the perfect Gift of the Father's Love. Let us rejoice in the Gift of Jesus in our lives!

SPECIAL PRAYERS: MONDAY JAN. 17 BIRTH OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING: As our country remembers the birth of Dr. King, we pray people of all races may learn to treat one another with dignity and respect.

JAN. 18-25 WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY: Jan. 18-25 is the traditional time of prayer for Christian unity: we pray that the Lord may give us the grace to heal the divisions among the many Christian faiths so that one day there may be truly "one flock, one Shepherd."

VOCATION CORNER:

Today we hear the great story of the Wedding Feast at Cana. Jesus is celebrating with the happy couple - a salute to the vocation of marriage. And, He honors His mother's request to intervene as the wine runs out. We are now issued the one of the greatest calls to holiness of the ages - "Do whatever He tells you". As this was the "beginning of his signs ..., and so revealed his glory", are we seeing His signs and doing whatever He tells us? Are we called to something greater?

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time - 16 January 2022

Isaiah 62:1-5. Psalm 96:1-2, 2-3, 7-8, 9-10.
1 Corinthians 12:4-11.

Believing Signs. At first glance, these readings lead us to bride and groom, gifts, and marriage. But there are important things underneath, important truths at the heart of these proclamations. God has not and will not abandon us (Isaiah).

Charisms, that is, gifts of the Spirit, are given to everyone to use for the common good, not just one's own good (Corinthians). The miracle of water to wine is the first of many signs of the Messiah, the Christ (John). God's signs and good activity are everywhere.

- ◆ What evidence do I have that God is with us still?
- ◆ What gifts that I have, given by the Spirit, will I put to use for the good of another?
- ◆ Christ is active all the time. What little and big signs of this goodness can I be part of? What signs will I rejoice in?
