In exchange, I will give you my life." Thanks be to God she was returned to us. I believe this experience was the moment when God began to prepare me for my vocation. He brought many people into my life along the way to teach me how to pray and form me in my faith. I eventually said yes to his call and entered seminary. The rest of the journey wasn't without its challenges, but by then I had learned to turn to the Lord and trust in his guidance.

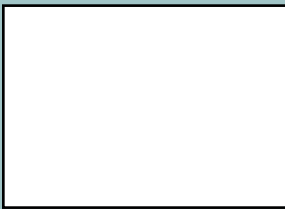

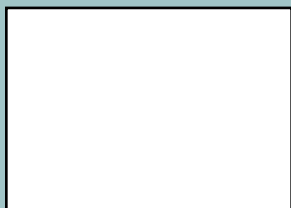
