Hello everybody!

A special welcome to all of our picnic guests! As we celebrate the wondrous solemnity of Pentecost, that time in which the disciples received that outpouring of the Holy Spirit, we are reminded that Pentecost is not limited to one event, one time, or one people, but it is the beginning of an outpouring that continues to this very day. Often referred to as the birthday of the Church, we now celebrate that continuation of the Love of God that dwells in our hearts!

God reveals his love to us in unique ways, but perhaps the most profound is in the Holy Eucharist. What begins as bread and wine are transformed into our Lord Jesus, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. May we never take the most Holy Sacrament for granted, but each day strive to fully welcome the presence of God within our hearts when we celebrate the Mass. Also important is to take some time before Blessed Sacrament, to pray in the presence of God.

In the words of the late evangelist Archbishop Fulton Sheen: ***"I keep up the Holy Hour to grow more and more into His likeness... Looking at the Eucharistic Lord for an hour transforms the heart in a mysterious way as the face of Moses was transformed after his companionship with God on the mountain. The Holy Hour is not a devotion; it is a sharing in the work of redemption. 'Could you not watch one hour with Me?' Not for an hour of activity did He plead, but for an hour of companionship. The purpose of the Holy Hour is to encourage deep personal encounter with Christ. The holy and glorious God is constantly inviting us to come to Him, to hold converse with Him and to ask such things as we need and to experience what a blessing there is in fellowship with Him. One of the by-products of the Holy Hour was the sensitiveness to the Eucharistic Presence of Our Divine Lord."*** (*Treasure in Clay, the Autobiography of Fulton J. Sheen (1980)*)

In two weeks, Sunday, June 19, we will have a unique opportunity to bear a public witness on the gift of the Holy Eucharist. Following the 8:30am Mass at St. Stephens, at 9:30am, we will process with our Lord in a Corpus Christi procession to St. Joseph's for benediction at 10:15am, preceding the 10:30am Mass. Please join us if you are able to walk with our Lord through the streets of Stevens Point, proudly bearing witness to the power of the Eucharist.

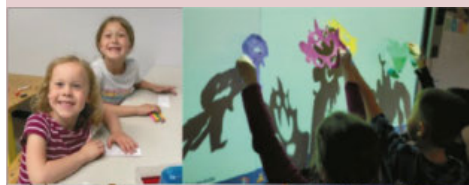

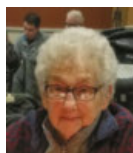


The St. Stephen students celebrated the end of the school year! We will miss their smiling faces on campus. Have a safe Summer!
