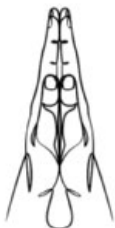
Hello everybody,

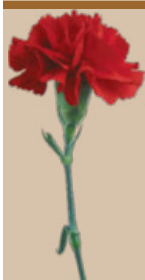
