Hello everybody,

As the old joke goes, we have two seasons in Wisconsin: Winter and Road Construction. Our Gospel today has the image of the servants waiting for their master's return. It calls us all to embrace vigilance and be ready for when God is going to speak to us. This message of prayerful patience is a great refresher for us all as we all need a little extra time, preparation, and prayer not only to traverse our fair city, but to continue our ultimate journey to unite our hearts fully to God's.

The challenge for us is that we really like things to happen right now. I can yell *Hey Siri, tell me the news* while I'm brushing my teeth and get caught up on current events. If we need to know what the forecast is, all we need to do is just need to swipe up on a smart watch and see if it is raining, no need to even look out a window! If I want to talk to a friend doing missionary work in a remote village on the other side of the world...I just figure out the time difference and we can video chat in real-time. Who needs to wait for that painfully slow post office anymore! Instant communication leads us to expect instant gratification.

Today may we challenge ourselves to realize that God's speed does not often reflect our own. Though our technology may be instant, often we need to be patient in our relationships with one another and the Lord. His ways are not instant dings on our phone, but quiet movements in our heart. If we are not alert to these movements, sometimes we miss them. This can lead us to wonder what's going on with God; when in reality we should wonder what's going on in my life that I can't hear? It is never a question as to if God is going to act in our life, but are we are patient enough to listen. Together we eagerly wait for the Lord in His love.


