I look forward to working with the staff at St. Bronislava and ministering to their parishioners for the next three months. I am thankful for our excellent staff, whom I will lean on to help hold down the fort. To aid us in our endeavors, I am also happy to announce a promotion. Kristi Vuorinen, our parish secretary, has been promoted to office manager. Once again, I ask for your prayers and patience as we continue our journey of faith together.




