April is Child Abuse Prevention Month. Did you know what is happening in our Archdiocese to protect children?

Safe environment training to identify warning signs and develop strategies for maintaining a safe environment for all is provided to all youth in Catholic schools and parish religious education programs and to adults who work or volunteer with children.

A designated Victim Assistance Coordinator (contact victimassistance@archlou.org) is available to receive reports and accompany victims through the journey.

A volunteer and independent Sexual Abuse Review Board assists Archbishop Shelton in the review of all cases and makes recommendations for moving forward.

A Safe Environment Coordinator (contact Scott Fitzgerald, sfitzgerald@archlou.org) assists parish and school personnel with training and background screenings for anyone who may have access to children.

An audit is conducted by an independent firm to evaluate our implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. For each audit, our Archdiocese has been found to be fully compliant with all elements of the Charter, with no required changes or recommendations for changes.

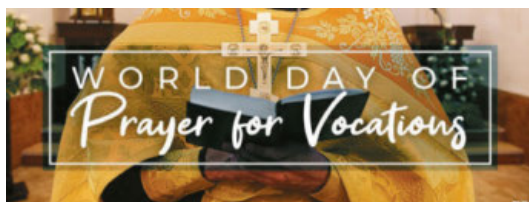

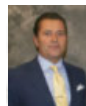
