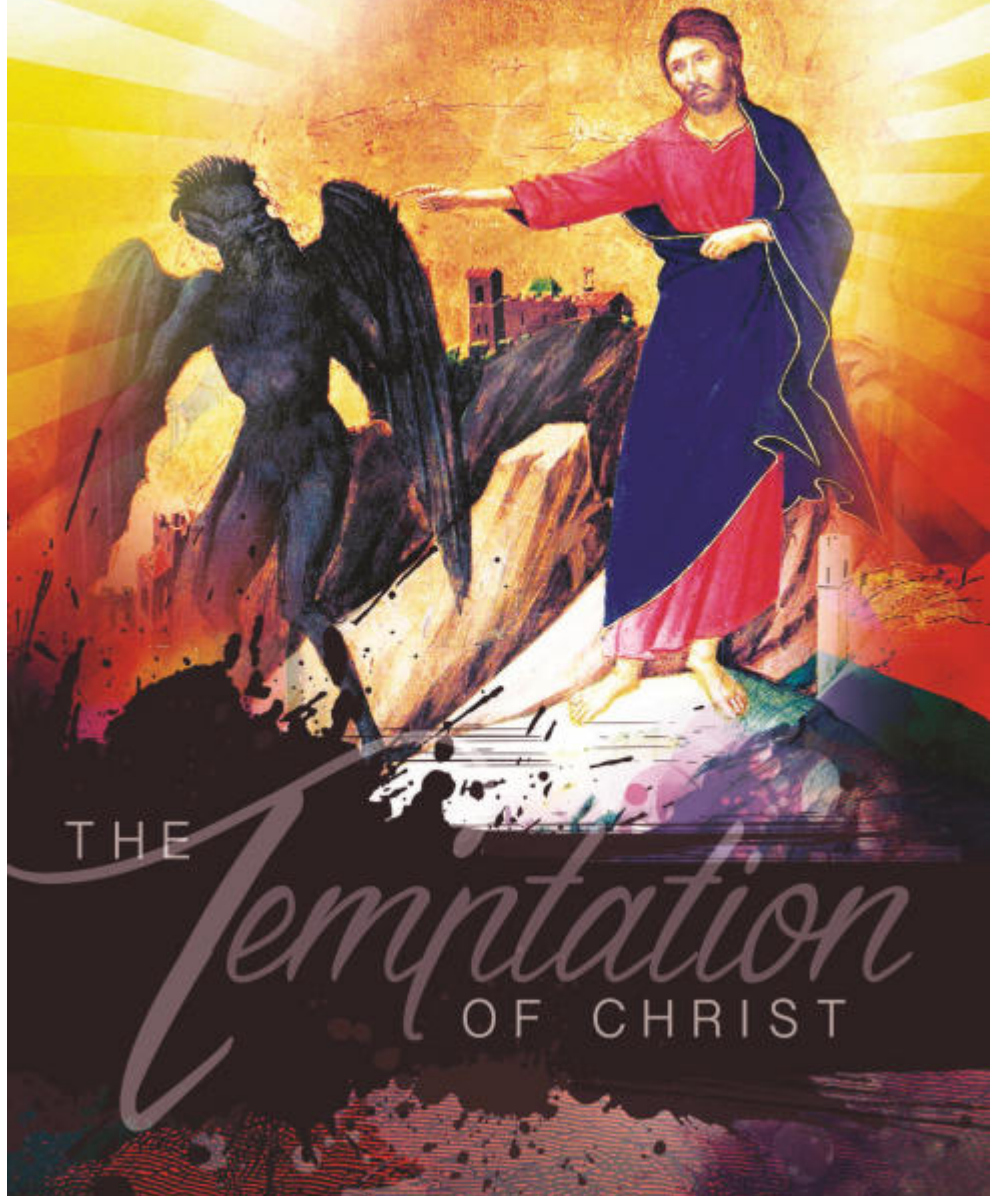

## OUTREACH INTENTION

### OUR OUTREACH INTENTION FOR MARCH AND APRIL WILL BE FOR SLEEP IN HEAVENLY PEACE.

Sleep in Heavenly Peace is a group of volunteers dedicated to finding those young children that do not have the luxury of sleeping on a bed or even laying their heads on a pillow. Through the wonderful efforts of volunteers and generous donations, bunk beds are built, assembled and delivered to those children who are otherwise sleeping on couches, blankets or even floors. These beds restore dignity, not only to the kids, but to the families that are struggling. Donations are used in the purchase, assembly, development, materials, delivery and organization of the beds.

Sleep in Heavenly Peace announced that Michael R. Prudhom of Racine has formed a Racine/Kenosha chapter of the organization to provide beds and bedding to ensure that every child in Racine and Kenosha has a bed. To date, the Racine/Kenosha chapter has provided beds to 114 kids. There are almost 200 more on the waiting list. Each twin bed costs between \$150-\$175 and includes a hand-built frame, mattress, pillow, linens and a blanket or quilt.

Beds are built by volunteers during "Build Days". The public is invited to join in bed-building. No previous construction skills are required. Bane-Nelson, Inc., in Kenosha has kindly donated space for building indoors.
